days.

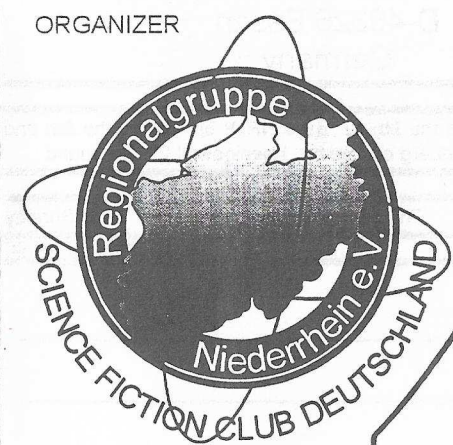
Apart from the traditional story workshops,
