There were some issues with the timing on meals – this was entirely down to unexpected numbers of people staying within the hotel, rather than using the outside options, which we had listed for people anticipating more take-up than occurred, at least partly because the hotel's food is both nice and well-priced. The hotel accept that this was not how they wished their service to be, and will be working to radically improve it this year. We would urge people to order their meals well in advance via the menu sheets provided each day, doing it as a last minute option will sadly not speed the service at all. Order in the morning for the evening meal!

Beer. We ordered a lot of beer in 2015, as people said they wanted it. Unfortunately, we did not DRINK a lot of beer and there was a large amount left over, at least partially because food was in the downstairs bar and beer was in the upstairs bar. We will be ordering smaller quantities this year, and making it available in both bars. If you want this to continue to be an option at conventions, then we'd urge you to partake. It may be that drinking habits of the convention as a whole have changed, in which case we need to take that on board. 2016 will act as a marker in the sand for beer consumption in the future.
