

The con had a sympathetic committee, and the program boasted both a concert and a room for late-night circles. To properly honour such unheard-of luxuries, a group known as Filker Abraham and the Smilks prepared a brand-new song. This lead to the now-traditional rallying cry "We're gonna get lynched!" The song was performed at the concert, not all the performers ran away quickly enough, and the rest is history.

However, there was one other who might have joined that august band, but for the vagaries of convention scheduling...

25 years ago I was sitting in a bar at an Eastercon when the people around me started writing a song... luckily for me I had to go do some costuming, and am therefore not listed amongst the ranks of filk smurfdom.

However, those fabled filkers were cursed and condemned to perpetuate the filking at a dedicated convention once a year, forever after. Thus it was that for quarter of a century the enthusiastic, the gifted, and the occasional not so gifted have haunted various hotels late into the night. From small cons in little family run hotels - one memorably with an electrical cut out when we got too loud - to huge corporate ones where we battled with mundane sports award ceremonies. (Phoenix proving more popular with the attendees of said ceremony than their own disco)

Over the years the spirit of the 'smilkers' has not waned and has brought us to the wilds of Grantham (well, perhaps not that wild), and I am still sitting on the sidelines listening to fabulous people sing. Long may it continue... Here's to the 50th celebration!
