What is Eastercon?

The British National Science Fiction convention (Eastercon) is a gathering for fans of science fiction and fantasy of all types, whether they like books, TV, film, comics or any other media.

Held annually since 1948, there is no event quite like it. As well as guest talks, there will be a mix of panels, masquerade, videos, games, filking, auction, art show and dealers room.

Fan-run conventions are not about buying an assigned seat in a theatre and sitting listening to a guest for an allotted time. They are about having a space, to move freely, talk, socialise, drink and eat, and see the guests at the convention in the formal atmosphere of a programme item and informally as they mingle with everyone else. You buy a membership to a fan-run convention, not a ticket.

Accommodation

There are 2,500 hotels in Blackpool – and that does not include holiday flats. So whatever your budget you will find one within walking distance from the convention venue. B & Bs start almost at the steps of the Winter Gardens. We have launched an accommodation booking service with the Blackpool Tourist Board. Details will be sent to members once they have registered.
