

About Concussion

Concussion – the 57th Eastercon – will take place in Glasgow over the weekend of 14th-17th April 2006. Bringing together authors and fans for four days of exciting, enjoyable and very varied programme, the Eastercon is the premier annual event of the UK's science fiction and fantasy calendar. We expect the best part of a thousand sf enthusiasts to join us in Glasgow – make sure that you are one of them!

Because Concussion was organized with rather less notice than most Eastercons, we are still finalising the details of our venue. However, we can confirm that we are putting the final touches to a deal with the Glasgow Moat House Hotel, and that we are arranging additional accommodation options nearby.

About Our Guests

M John Harrison is one of the UK's most renowned sf and fantasy authors. Winner of the Tiptree Award for *Light* (a work also shortlisted for the Clarke Award), he has received popular and critical acclaim for works such as *The Course of the Heart, The Centauri Device* and the *Viriconium* series.



Elizabeth Hand is a noted US fantasy writer and another winner of multiple awards. Her novels include Winterlong and Mortal Love, and her work has been variously described as lush, degenerate and evocative.



Justina Robson is one of the latest wave of British SF writers. Books like Silver Screen, Mappa Mundi and Natural History prove that she is one of the most exciting talents to have emerged in the past five years.

Brian Froud is a legendary fantasy artist, whose paintings have inspired films like The Dark Crystal and Labyrinth. Brian illustrated Lady Cottington's Pressed Fairy Book and his latest work is Goblins!



Ian Sorensen is our fan guest and a seasoned convention organizer. He has published fanzines such as Conrunner and Snapshot, and as part of the 'Reductio Ad Absurdum' theatre company, stages SF epics with a cast of only three.

We also plan to bring a number additional guests to Concussion for items on particular days of the convention. Our final lineup of these Day Guests will not be confirmed until close to the event, but so far we hope to bring Games Workshop fiction editor **Marc Gascoigne**, award-winning Finnish sf writer **Johanna Sinisalo**, noted comics and fantasy author **Dan Abnett** and, subject to professional commitments, visual effects and space expert **Mat Irvine**.

Our Programme

Concussion will be a general-interest convention, centring on written sf and fantasy but featuring comics, anime, gaming, costuming, film and (last but in no way least) fan programme. We will devote a lot of effort to ensuring that the programme is as varied and interesting as we can make it, and that it will be fun and rewarding for participants and audience alike.

In answer to one common question, we do plan to run a Masquerade – but it would help us immensely if you could let us know well in advance if you are thinking of taking part.

Children's rates apply to children who will be the appropriate age at the convention, under 18's must attend with a responsible adult. Supporting membership may be upgraded to attending at any time by paying the difference between the supporting and attending rates prevailing at the time of conversion. Concessionary memberships are available to the unemployed, full-time students and people on State Benefits. If concessionary conditions no longer apply on the day of the convention, the concessionary membership will be treated as a supporting membership, which will require an upgrade to attending as above.

Membership records will be held on a computer database. Membership details will not be passed on to other organisations with the exception of Eastercon 2007, who will be given a one-time only use so that you can receive PR1 and joining information.
