Progress Report, the Final

Final Progress Report

#DY66

Hello and welcome to the final progress report for Dysprosium. We're so happy (and relieved) that you have chosen to join us as a member and we hope that you will have an amazing convention.

Part of enjoying any convention is understanding and knowing what to expect. Many of you are old Eastercon hats but there is a significant percentage of new folk who have never attended an Eastercon before. This is also a new hotel and so it will present its own challenges. This Progress Report aims to help smooth things over as much as possible.

The hashtag for this event is #DY66 and we will be monitoring the @DysprosiumCon account during the convention so feel free to find us in Ops, on Twitter or wandering around aimlessly during the convention if you need any help.

HERE (The Park Inn)

The distances within the Park Inn are not vast but going from one end of one end to the end of the other is significant enough we feel we should mention it. It is over 200m from one end of one side of the conference centre to the other end of the other side. We do have time between programme items to allow for movement between rooms but please do note if you have trouble walking that you may need to bring support. Please do note that shoes must be worn in *ALL* public areas of the hotel and we do not have all rooms all nights so there may be non-convention members around the public areas.

GETTING HERE

Buses from Heathrow are free and our intrepid Head of Communications will be on one herself at around noon on the Friday as she arrives in from Romania where she will have been at a conference (she needs this as much as any and she also leaves this as a travel plan for her husband in the hopes he makes the drive smoothly from home).

The Park Inn Heathrow is situated alarmingly close (for sleepy

drivers) to the exit from the slip road to Heathrow. You'll see the sign because the hotel is right NEXT to the road in fact. This requires that you immediately be aware of the turn for the hotel while exiting the slip road onto Bath Road. T is immediately to your left. Missed it? Take the next immediate left and that is the road next to the hotel. Not coming from the M4? Lucky you! The hotel is right on Bath Road as a major traffic-lighted intersection so it is easy and safe to approach. Here is the address for you brave GPSers: Bath Road Heathrow Middlesex UB7 0DU.

The TfL buses from Heathrow leave from Heathrow and all of them are free to the hotels. They are generally quite busy at rush hour we have found so if arriving then, just chill. We don't run them so we're afraid we can only offer this information subject to the whims and vagaries of the individual transport providers. Very kindly James, one of our members, wrote the following having experienced the attempt to find the free buses:

For anyone going to Eastercon by public transport (including planes), you might find this diagram useful:

There's a free bus network around the airport run by various organisation. If you're arriving by train or coach, or any flight into Terminals 1-3, head for the central bus station, which is next to the London Underground station. You can get any of the routes 105, 111, 140, 285 and 555, which pass close to the Park Inn, though you'll have to walk a short distance from the bus stop. There's also the N9 night bus, but several of the above routes run 24 hours anyway. The journey takes about 8 minutes, and there are buses leaving every few minutes.

From Terminal 4 it's not quite so easy. You can take the 555 bus for free. It runs every 30 minutes, but it only runs from 4am to 8pm, so if you need to get there in the evening, you'll need other options. You can also take the Heathrow Express to T1-3 for free, and take any of the buses from the central bus stations from there. However, after about midnight, options are much more limited.

From Terminal 5 you can take the 423, which is also free and will

leave you close to the Park Inn. This runs every 20 mins from 4am to 12:30am. You also have the option of the Heathrow Express to T1-3 and any of the routes from Central Station.

It's also worth noting that you can use the London Underground for free within Heathrow area, but you need an Oyster card to avail of this.

If you are staying in any of the other Heathrow hotels, these routes may also be useful to you. A lot of the hotels along Bath road are easily walkable, but some of the further ones are a bit of a trek. We won't be running any services from any hotels so sadly if you aren't in the main hotel it will either be public transport, walking or driving.

The hotel is so close to the airport it almost isn't worth a cab but that is also an option. Taxi ranks are located in each terminal but please **ONLY** use a licensed taxi cab.

Bicycles are going to struggle along the Bath Road due to the volume and weight of traffic but with the hotel at traffic lights it is safer than some to cross over to. Please be careful and obey the law.

PARKING

Please note that there are no cycle racks outside the hotel and arrangements should be made with the hotel prior to arrival for safe cycle storage.

Parking for all but HGVs is both outside the hotel and the safe NCP parking lot. We have in/out privileges with the hotel but not NCP so please plan your visit accordingly. The hotel and NCP both operate park and fly services so both will be busy. We have arranged parking in both the hotel and the NCP at £5 per vehicle per day. Do not use the machines in either car park to pay for your parking. In the hotel car park, register your licence plate at Reception and either pay or charge to your room. In the NCP, take your ticket to the attendant and he will take payment manually.

For those arriving by larger spacecraft and hovercraft, the same rules apply as for HGVs – the parking lot is not rated for heavier or wider vehicles so please arrange spacecraft and larger hovercraft parking with the appropriate locations.

We have a very limited number of T.A.R.D.I.S. spaces due to the nature of their size and structure. Please arrange parking of these with the hotel prior to arrival.

ON CHECK-IN

Because the hotel neglected to take a deposit on your initial booking (their fault), they will pre-charge your room £50 per night and the balance will be charged on check-out.

RESPECT THE FURNITURE

We will have some of the additional furniture from around the hotel brought in to the common rooms and some from before the refurbishment. Please note that we do not own this furniture and so we need to keep it looking pristine for the most part. Please help us not have a massive bill after the convention by treating all furniture with respect. Respecting the furniture includes: not drawing on it; not snapping legs or arms off it; not cutting it; not ripping it; not spilling food and/or drink on it and leaving it to set; not standing or jumping on it; not leaving bodily fluids on it; etc. Anyone found deliberately damaging any hotel furniture will have their membership suspended and may be held fully liable for the cost of repair or replacement.

MISCELLANEOUS HOTEL INFORMATION

For 30 minutes between 0200 and 0230 each morning, there will be no transactions while the hotel does their close of day process.

On Monday at 1700 there will be a 5-second fire alarm test. Do not be alarmed.

HOTEL FOOD

We have worked out a deal with the hotel and they will be providing very reasonably priced food as well as their standard fare throughout the convention. From Breakfast Baps to evening meals, we're hoping you'll be joining us for more than just the real ale bar as we have a minimum food and beverage target to achieve and just by enjoying a snack you'll help us. There are facilities in the hotel for eating and we have a special discount food deal as well as having regular food. There is a restaurant, a bar area with bar snacks and a Costa Coffee (according to the website).

For Friday, Saturday and Sunday evening, the chef is kindly going to theme the menu - one night The Americas (burgers, Tex-Mex etc), one night Asian (Thai, stir fry's, etc) and one night European (French, Italian, Spanish etc). There will be some staples but it means there will be variety without travelling far. They will do sausage buns, bacon buns and egg buns for breakfast to purchase if you're at another hotel, and buns again at midnight you can purchase, but they have asked us to encourage people to buy a voucher during the day/evening if they think they might be up for a late-night snack so that they have a ball-park number of requirements. We felt that seemed fair so they can cater for us correctly and not waste food.

To minimise the amount of money they have to handle, the hotel will be selling vouchers for all meals and the midnight snacks. If you would like to speed up the queues, please go to Hotel Reception where there will be a desk for you to purchase the vouchers you might need. You can pay cash or credit/debit card, or charge it to your room. The various food locations will also take cash, but there will be no card or room charge payments.

At breakfast time: Breakfast rolls with a vegetarian option £4 each

Lunch: a selection of sandwiches and paninis, Burgers and hot dogs from £5 or a 3-course meal at £15 per person in the restaurant.

Dinner: a selection of sandwiches and paninis, Burgers and hot dogs from £5 or a 3-course meal at £18 per person in the restaurant.

At midnight: Bacon rolls, Egg rolls or vegetarian option £4 each.

AREA EATERIES

We understand that you won't want to eat on site every day (OK, some of us do but some don't and that's totally OK) and so we have created an initial list of some places to eat nearby besides the usual McDonalds. This list is not comprehensive and is *UNCHECKED* so the food could be brilliant or it could be awful. We hope that as the convention progresses that you will submit mini eatery reviews for us to publish in the newsletter. "Imagineering" starships has been a substantial activity in "hard" SF for a long time but there is still only one full (first level) engineering design for a starship, Daedalus, done back in the 1970s. The Initiative for Interstellar Studies (i4is.org) will be at Dysprosium with a team who will try to connect a few of those "hard" SF ideas with real physics and engineering. Our experts are in the forefront of the current new wave of interstellar studies and they will be bending their brains to see if they can make those fictional starships work. Suggestions welcome!

In another part of the great Dysprosium show, one of our i4is team will also be showing you how you can figure out the dynamics of a starship using the humble spreadsheet. Mighty brains like Konstantin Tsiolkovsky stood on the shoulders of giants like Newton and Al Karismi but those of us who have forgotten most of our hard physics and maths can still amaze the kids - until they show they know more about spreadsheets than we do, of course!

CHILDREN AT DY66

Children aged 6 and older must have a purchased child membership or day membership for the convention, while children under 5 must be registered as infants. All children under 12 must be accompanied by a responsible guardian.

All children registered as Junior members may move around the convention and can participate in items appropriate to their age. If a Junior member is being disruptive or they are attempting to gain

access to age inappropriate activities, their Junior status will be downgraded to Child and they will be required to be accompanied at all times by a responsible guardian. The decision to downgrade will be taken by a committee member and the decision is final.

PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEO

Please be polite and ask before taking photographs or recordings of members and attendees whenever possible. Video and audio recording and photography for personal archival use only is generally acceptable, unless individuals make it clear that they do not wish to be photographed or recorded, either by wearing a 'no photography' badge or by any other means. In that case, any specific photography or recording of them is expressly forbidden. Anyone who persists in filming/recording/photographing Dysprosium members who have denied their consent will be expelled from the convention.

WEAPONS POLICY

No actual weapon, or any item that can be mistaken for one, may be carried either openly or concealed at any time on properties being used for Dysprosium, with the following exceptions:

- If you want to carry a weapon or are unsure whether your weapon might be considered realistic, you must present it to Operations. They are the final arbiter of whether the item may be carried and whether it requires peace-bonding.
- Any actual weapon, or any item that can be mistaken for one, that you have purchased in the Marketplace must be wrapped and immediately transported to your hotel room or vehicle. If you want to carry the item at the convention, please refer to the previous point.
- If an actual weapon, or any item that can be mistaken for one, is part of your Masquerade costume, you must transport it to and from the staging area wrapped securely unless the item is peace-bonded. The Masquerade director must approve your use of any weapons during the Masquerade Ball.

- Live steel is prohibited under all circumstances. Operations are the final arbiter of what constitutes live steel.
- Any weapon, whether actual, realistic, or toy/prop, that is used in a threatening or harmful manner may result in confiscation of the item and/or removal of your membership or pass without refund.
- The only allowable variation to this policy will be for any convention scheduled programme demonstrations and sanctioned activities in designated areas at specific times, which have been risk assessed.

Failure to adhere to any of the above policies is grounds for the removal of your membership or pass without refund.
