HUNGRY

Leeds is a largish city with many good places to eat. Close to the University their are several takeaways and indian restaurants aiming at the student market. For curries we recommend The Kashmir, Theo's does the best kebabs and Milano's does acceptable Pizza. 15 min from the university is Brudenall Grove which has:-Stan Chee's a nice Chinese place that also does decent fish and chips, Caesar's a pizza place that also sells a wide range of junk food, and another pizza place Fizzy Joe's. Also on Brudenall Grove pistachio fans will find that the International Supermarket is economical, if you do not object to Iranian produce.

Salvo's is a highly regarded Italian restaurant in Headingly, by bus catch a 93/96 (about every 10 min) outside the university and ask for Safeways.

In town their is Mario's, an Italian restaurant and Sang Sang a chinese restaurant, both are good and on the Headrow, about a 20 min walk from the university (or you can catch a 93/96).

If you like wholefood or vegetarian Strawberry Field on Woodhouse lane, 5 min down from the university, is the place for you and any unrepentant carnivores you take along be happy too.

If you like to eat the same food were ever you may go, Briggate is the place for you:-Mac Donalds, Burger King, Pizza Hut and Pizza Hut all await your custom.

LEEDS

Leeds is an enjoyable place to go shopping, the city centre contains several Arcades, in which individual shops centre on their chosen theme; a random selection is hats and comics (Grand Arcade), pens and tobacco (Thornville Arcade). Their are many small boutiques of which quite a few are selling the seventies look, a chance for older fen to relive the wild abandon of a bizarre youth. The corn exchange contains numerous small shops which are varied in their themes, for example one basement shop abounds with fascinating wooden toys, while another does its best to convert adults to safe pleasure, with its wide selection of condoms. Leeds Indoor Market gives the impression of selling just about everything, and is an enjoyable place to visit if rather crowded on Saturdays. Granary Wharf is open on both Saturday and Sunday and has a stall selling a very nice range of handmade truffles and chocolate shapes. Chocolate fiends are warned that Leeds has a generous helping of Thorntions the nearest one is in the Merrion Centre. Granary Wharf also sells Celtic goods, Indian woodwork, games, instruments, old photo's of Leeds, aromatherapy and more.

Leeds largest independent record shop is in the St John's Centre, Jumbo Records. Leeds also abounds in remainder bookshops, there is one in the Merrion centre (SF tends to be on the back-wall) which is good for children's books, classics, gardening, arty books and cookery. There is also remainder book shops in the Schofield centre, Briggate and in the vicinity of C&A.

Leeds City Centre Art Gallery has two exhibitions of paintings by Leeds artists and a varied main collection. Unfortunately the Henry Moor Institute currently has no exhibition.

The Yorkshire Dales are of course a lovely place to visit after the con but if you want to see something green, Leeds Temple Newton is a large park with matching Stately Home:-by Bus take the 1/28 (10 min past the hour and then every 15 min) from the university to Eastgate and catch the 21 at

13 past the hour. Roundhay Park is the largest park in Leeds and is very pleasant catch the 1/28 (10 min past the hour and then every 15 min) to Lewis go round the corner to New Briggate stand N3 to catch 2/3 at 8/38 min past the hour. The Hyde Park is just behind the University and in daylight a pleasant spot, after dark it is a no go area.
