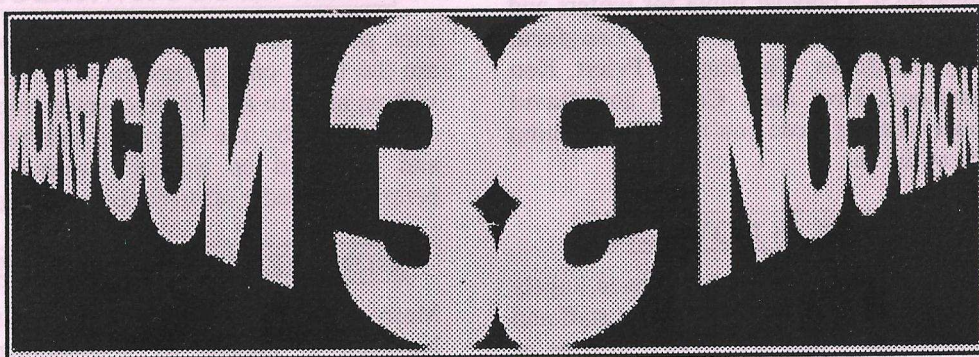

WHAT IS NOVACON?

Novacon is the Birmingham Science Fiction Group's annual convention, held every autumn in the Midlands since 1971. It's the UK's largest regional sf / fannish convention, second in size only to the national event held each Easter.

WHAT HAPPENS THERE?

Novacon is renowned for its combination of laid-back ambience with strong programming, the latter placing the emphasis both on written sf and cutting-edge science.

WHO'S GUEST OF HONOUR?

One of the rising stars in British science fiction, **Jon Courtenay Grimwood's** books include *Pashazade*, *Effendi*, *neoAddix*, *redRobe* and *reMix*. Roz Kaveney applauded his brand of "superior brain candy", whilst *The Bookseller* praised *reMix's* "vivid gore, sex and high-octane adventure. In addition, Jon is a regular genre reviewer for *SFX* and *The Guardian*.

ANYONE ELSE ATTENDING I MIGHT RECOGNISE?

Novacon is a popular haunt for writers and artists, with **Iain Banks**, **David Langford**, **Gwyneth Jones**, **Christopher Priest**, **Ken MacLeod**, **Prof Jack Cohen** and **David Hardy** among those you're likely to bump into in the bar.

WHERE IS NOVACON?

Walsall's **Quality Hotel** has proven hugely popular – great facilities, excellent staff and management – and is delighted to have us back for a third year. Just off the M6, it's ideally sized, with a central lounge bar perfect for finding your friends easily, or

making new ones; programme, bar, art show, bar, dealers' room and bar are all on one level (that's right: no lifts, no stairs).

WHO'S RUNNING NOVACON?

WHAT ABOUT AWARDS?

First presented in 1973, the Nova Awards are the UK's only prizes for fanzines, fan writing and fan art. These coveted trophies are decided by the Novacon membership and presented on Sunday evening (just before we wander off to the beer tasting).

DID I HEAR "FANZINES"?

More so than any other UK convention, Novacon is famous as a gathering of fanzine editors, artists and editors – the bar on Friday is often a frenzied blur of paper,

as fans hand out their latest issues. Why not join in the fun by publishing your own?

SHOULD I BRING MONEY?

There'll be a busy dealers' room (nearly as large as the programme room) for you to hand over your spare change to those impoverished booksellers (not forgetting those whose tables are stacked high with jewellery, models and crafts): go on, you know they need it more than you. Last year's auctions were also a great success – so don't forget to bring along books, artwork, videos, and all those *truly weird* items people only buy when it's aid of a cash-strapped fan fund.

WHAT'S A BEER TASTING?

And you call yourself a sf fan. Once again, we plan to finish the weekend with some more exotic beers and return to a bit more *tasting* and a bit less *quaffing*.

Back in the lounge bar, we'll also have the highly popular Black Sheep real ale throughout the weekend, as well as the famous Addlestones real cider.

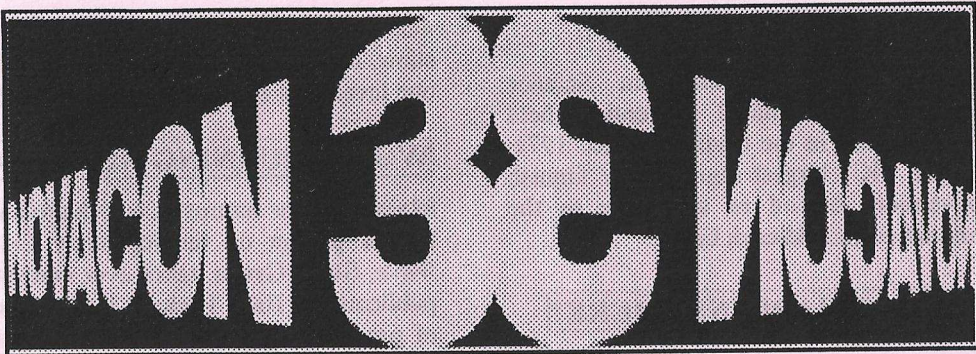
