### BRYAN TALBOT

Bryan managed to find himself as a Not A Guest of Honour by first of all signing up as a normal member of the convention and then agreeing to doing some talks, panels debates etc. This tends to show him up as the nice person he is. It doesn't say a lot about his talent as a writer/artist though and believe me, he is talented. His first foray into professional comics was in the early seventies with BRAINSTORM; his latest with his invitation to take over GENESIS the WARLOCK in 2000 AD. In between there exists a great deal of excellent work, especially his Luther Arkwright stories, which blend together, history, the future, alternative dimensions, differing timelines, goddies, haddies, James Bond etc. into a coherent, intelligent, relevant storyline. No mean feat. Reading Luther requires as much commitment from the reader as was obviously put in by the writer... not your every day image of a comic book. Bryan is like many present day comic writers/artists, in that he treats his audience as adult and expects them to treat his stories the same way. As a person he is great fun, too generous for his own good ("Yes, of course I'll do a talk on the History of Comics; sure I'll take part in some panels for you, yes, by all means...") and just insane enough to fit in with the rest of us. You will recognise him easily by his hair, and buy him a drink when you do; you'll find yourself on the receiving end of a good conversation...

### VIDEO

We will be showing every episode of all the series of these television shows over the weekend: Star Trek, Blake's Seven, The Prisoner, The Hitchhiker's Guide To The Galaxy, Gay of the Triffids, The Black Adder and Robin of Sherwood. (Please note that when we say EVERY episode, we mean every episode. This includes the whole of the first season of Blake's Seven.)  
Again we stress the point that these items will only be transmitted into the bedrooms at the Ingroup and those especially interested in seeing them are advised to book their rooms as early as possible in order to avoid disappointment.

For those convinced that they will miss at least three episodes of their favourite serial due to the necessity of eating, sleeping and the results of drinking over the weekends, rest assured that you have been catered for. The video programme has been left blank for the latter part of Sundays if you drop a

note to those in the video control room, (previously known as the Manager's Office) with the details of the missed episode, we will attempt to reshow it. Obviously, the more requests any particular episode has, the better chance it has of being shown again.

#### WARGAMING

There are two wargaming areas in the Hotel; two interconnecting rooms high in the dizzy heights and an open area deep in the bowels. The interconnecting rooms (The Wargaming Suite) will be run on a block booking system. You can book playing time in advance (in 6 hour blocks) and, if there is time vacant, on the day of the con. The open area (between the main hall and the largest bar) will contain one large continuous game/s and you take pot luck on getting in to play. You, or any group, can pre-book time in the Wargaming suite by getting in touch with Wolf Corbett, address at the back.

#### ART ROOM

Sue Mason is running the Art Room and those wishing to exhibit their work should get in touch with her, stating number and size of items and their approximate value (for insurance purposes). Those with working models please remember to state if you will need access to an electric point.

As fixing art to display boards has been a problem with conventions of late, please remember to state if art is suitable to be hung by cord or fixed by blue tack to backing etc.

Bid sheets will be available for those selling their work. The Art Auction will take place on Sunday morning and the usual auction charge of 10% will be levied.

#### WRITING COMPETITION

Those of literary aspirations can attempt to construct a prize winning short story within the following restrictions and present it to either the Chairman, by post, or to those on the registration desk by 6 o'clock on the Friday of the con.

The story must be no longer than 3 000 words and no shorter than 1 500.

It must either start with one of the following four phrases OR include the rhyme somewhere in the text.

The rain was heavy with the scent of air. (this is not a typo...)

"But I am sure I saw..."

The river flowed gently towards the cliff and then threw itself off the edge

Golden afternoon sunlight slanted through the coloured glass

My first is in Death  
My second in Pain  
Twirl my third around  
And I will come fourth again

Entries must be typed, double spaced and on one side of paper only. The author's name must not be on the manuscript itself but in a separate, sealed envelope firmly attached to the title page. The word count must be included on the script itself.

#### FILMS

As you would expect, we have a lot of good films booked for the weekend and we are just dying to tell you what they are. However, as a few of you will know, due to some obscure ruling on copyright law we are allowed to book and show films at convention but not actually name or advertise them... Suffice to say, fans of early Ralph Bakshi films will be catered for. We are confident that those of a horrific rock disposition shall be pleased and we shall definitely encourage members to spend sleepless nights viewing a continuous show of the very worst that hollywood has to offer. Please do not bring your own tomatoes to throw at the screen, we will provide killer ones of our own... You will just have to wait till the actual programme on the day to know any more...

#### FILKING

For you filkers, we have myriad delights to come. As well as a WHOLE BAR to your self for singing in all night, we are planning a performance of new filk songs, by some of the best filkers around. So if you are interested in those good old folk songs of the future; this is the convention for you. #### SECURITY

As usual, the main security warning with any con is that members must be wearing their convention badges All THE TIME. Anyone not clearly showing their badge will not be allowed entrance to any of the convention rooms. We would ask that everyone please remember this, it is a nuisance but it must be done.

An equally important warning is that there will not be any drinking, eating or

smoking allowed within the Book Room, Art Room or Computer Room. There will be a table on the outside of each of these rooms for you to deposit your pint and your bag before you go in, reclaiming them as you leave. Anyone found breaking this rule will be handed over to the offended dealer/artist/computer... have you seen what Richard Van der Voort can do with a crowbar...? Not to mention what Sue Mason can do with a short dagger...?

A point to remember at CONQUEST is that we will allow members to wear weapons, as part of costume etc. but they must be 'peace-strung' or otherwise rendered harmless.
