

## Edinburgh's First Science Fiction Convention

february 4th-6th 1983

HA CON is Edinburgh's first science fiction convention, and will take place over the first weekend in February 1983, the 4th to the 6th, in the Grosvenor Centre Hotel. The programme will include films, panels and discussions, and in addition there will be a limited alternative programme to cater for minority interests, and hopefully a video programme. For those more interested in the social aspects of Conventions, the hotel is well-supplied with bar space, and there will be room for display of fanzines and other fan activity. Those seeking to lose themselves in wargames for the weekend will also find space available. There will, of course, be a Book Room, where SF dealers will be offering their wares, and an Art Show for display of both professional and amateur work.

Guest of Monour is leading author Harry Harrison (The Stainless Steel Rat and Deathworld series, and more recently Homeworld and Wheel-world), well-known to Convention-goers as a dynamic personality who will help to ensure the success of any Con. The fan artist Guest of Honour is Pete Lyon, renowned both for his painting skills and for his fanzine work.

RA CON is being organised by FORTH, the Edinburgh SF fan group, and the committee includes Chris Anderson, Hal Broome, Jim Darroch, Phil Dawson, Mitch Hunter, Keith Mitchell, Euan Morton, Andrew Rose and Owen Whiteoak.

The Grosvenor Centre Hotel is centrally located, just two minutes from Haymarket Station, and within easy reach of shops, restaurants and snack bars. For those wishing to stay in the convention hotel, room rates have not been finally agreed, but preliminary negotiations indicate that they will be inexpensive. Full details will be available for Progress Report 1, to be produced by next Easter.

Full attending membership costs £7, and supporting membership (which entitles you to receive all convention literature, but <u>not</u> to attend) costs £3.50p. These prices will be subject to increases in summer 1982 and February 1983, so join now to take advantage of these prices. Pre-supporting members have until 1st July 1982 to convert to supporting or attending membership and still receive their £2 discount.
