Restaurant Guide

This guide focuses on restaurants close to the Boskone hotel. It is not intended to be an extensive guide to Boston's many hundreds of fine restaurants. The information in this guide is as accurate as we could determine at the time we went to press. But it is always best to confirm with a phone call before setting out to a restaurant. We will have menus from most of these restaurants available for reference at the information desk. In addition, a binder of menus that deliver to the Boskone can be found there. Note: Many restaurants with bars close their kitchens before close of business.

Transportation Options

Walking

Summer Street - The hotel is located on this street. The restaurants listed below are Northwest of the hotel. As you come out of the main lobby, face the street & MBTA station and take a left.

Congress Street This runs almost parallel to Summer Street but below the level of the main hotel lobby. There are 3 ways to get there:

- You can walk down D Street towards the water & MBTA station. (D Street is alongside the hotel). Congress Street crosses D Street.
- You can also take the elevated World Trade Center Avenue (also called Viaduct St.) towards the harbor. At Congress St., there are stairs to the left side and an elevator in the WTC Silver Line station on the right.
- You can also get down to Congress St from Summer St. There is a staircase at A St. Although this is the shortest route, if the weather is icy, it is better to take other routes which will make the walk longer.

Sleeper St and Farnsworth St - Follow the directions for Congress St. walking towards the Boston Skyline. These side streets are on the right.

Northern Ave and Seaport Blvd - These are along the harbor waterfront, so you would begin by walking toward the harbor on either D St. (which passes alongside the hotel) or the elevated World Trade Center Ave (also called Viaduct St.). After 1/4 mile on D St, you will reach *Northern Avenue*, which runs parallel to the waterfront. There you would turn either right or left, depending on the restaurant. If you use WTC Ave, you need to go down. You can enter the Seaport Hotel on the right and use their elevators or at the very end, under the arch of the WTC Pier, there is a glass-enclosed stairway, elevator, and an 'up' escalator.

Seaport Lane - This runs between Seaport Blvd and Congress. It is parallel to D Street and WTC Ave.

Fish Pier - Follow D St to the end heading towards the harbor. Fish Pier is straight ahead at the end of D st..

Dry Dock Ave - As you come out of the main lobby, face the harbor & MBTA station and take a right onto Summer Street. Dry Dock Ave is on your left.

Broadway (West and East) If you go down D Street away from the Harbor, you will reach W. Broadway in South Boston. At Dorchester Street, West Broadway becomes East Broadway. Another way to East Broadway is to come out of the main lobby, face the harbor and take a right onto Summer Street, it becomes L St. East Broadway crosses L St. Or take a taxi for about \$6-\$8.

A St. and Dorchester Ave. If you go 3/4 of a mile down D Street away from the Harbor, you will reach W. 2nd St on right. This will run into both A Street and Dorchester Ave. Or take a taxi for about \$8.

Dorchester Street - Not to be confused with Dorchester Ave. It is where West Broadway becomes East Broadway. Follow the instructions for Broadway or come out of the main hotel lobby, face the water and take a right onto Summer St. Summer Street becomes L St. Take a right onto East Broadway. Dorchester St intersects East and West Broadway. Or take a taxi for about \$7.

Taxi

The 2011 rates for cabs in Boston is \$2.60 for the first 1/7 mile, and \$0.40 for each additional 1/7 mile. Passenger pays no toll from Boston proper to East Boston, not including Logan Airport. (You will pay a toll coming from East Boston to Boston proper.) When giving distances to the restaurants we are providing the walking distance; cab distance may be more depending on one-way streets, traffic patterns, etc. A few phone numbers: Boston Cab 617-262-2227, Yellow Cab 617-628-0600, ITOA 617-323-6000. Taxis are required to accept credit cards. Boston Cab has wheelchair accessible vehicles but advanced notice is recommended. Use <http://boston.taxiwiz.com/> to determine approximate fares.

Silver Line Waterfront

The Silver Line Waterfront is a "bus rapid transit" line that links South Boston and Logan Airport to South Station. (This does not connect directly to the Silver Line Washington Street.) The nearest Silver Line rapid transit station is the WTC Station on WTC Avenue, a bit under 1/4 mile from the hotel. The Silver Line runs about every 15 minutes on weekends. The MBTA uses a card-based fare system. You can buy individual paper tickets called Charlie Tickets or use a stored-value plastic card called a Charlie Card.

The rapid transit fares are cheaper if you use the Charlie Card, but the empty Charlie Cards are only available at certain distribution points, such as South Station or the 7-Eleven by the World Trade Center. (On sale Mon-Sat 7am to 7pm). As of Jan. 1, 2007, rapid transit one-way fare is \$2, or \$1.70 when using a Charlie Card. Transfers within the rapid transit network are free. Transfers between rapid transit and bus are free if you use the Charlie Card; other wise you pay full fare for each segment. 1-day and 7-day LinkPasses provide unlimited travel throughout the system. A 1-day LinkPass is \$9 and a 7-day LinkPass is \$15. You can use their trip planning tool:
