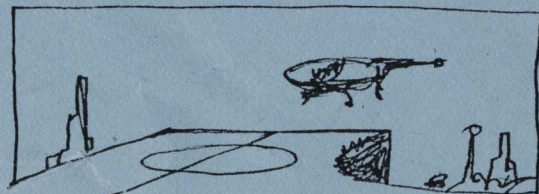

Operations - Remington or Russell Room

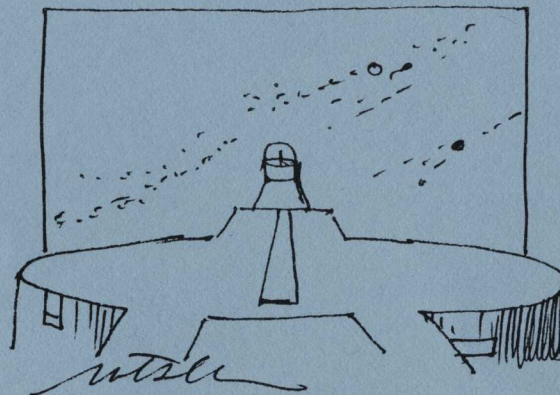
Operations will open on a 24-hr. basis starting Friday. If you have any problems that we can help with, come see us.
