If you are planning on hosting a party at LepreCon, you **must** register with the Con by March 15, 1989 or your party will be shut down by the hotel, especially if you are serving alcohol to minors. We are working on special prices from the hotel for registered parties to buy beer at reduced rates to help make it easier for you. The drinking age in Arizona is 21, if you are under that age during the Con, you may not drink alcoholic beverages.

Vandalism cannot be tolerated. In the past year, we have had over \$1000 in damages due to vandalism. If these problems are not stopped, conventions in Phoenix will end because hotels will no longer be willing to work with us.

Remember, attending a Con is a **privilege**, not a right. We reserve the right to revoke membership for cause, and you must wear your badge at all times. In the past we have worked to make the conventions fun for people with a wide variety of interests and behaviors. Please help us in making Cons an event like the old days where all fans were friends, and all were welcome.

Art Show

Hotel

Once again the Phoenix Hyatt Regency will be hosting LepreCon. This year we will not be on Easter, so we will not be competing with the Easter Brunch. However since this weekend is still in peak season, the hotel will be full. Therefore, LepreCon's special rates of \$57 single/double/triple/quad will be honored for LepreCon members only. You will either need to be a pre-registered member or have your badge with you when you check in to your

room. It is also important that you reserve your room well in advance as our room block is only held through March 14,1989. Quads or Double/Double rooms are extremely limited, so if you want one of them reservations must be made even earlier. Dealer's Room

This year's Dealer's Room will be limited to 35 to 40 tables and we are nearly half sold out.
