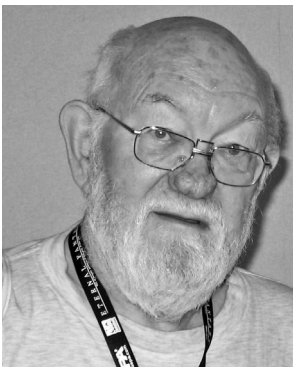
# Guests of Honor



## KIM STANLEY ROBINSON

Kim Stanley Robinson was born in Waukegan, Illinois, but grew up in Southern California. He received a BA in Literature in 1974, an MA in 1975, and a Ph. D. in 1982. Robinson is well known for his various 'series' including Three Californias, The Mars Trilogy, and Science in the Capital.

Robinson's awards include the Hugo for Best Novel for *Green Mars* (1994) and *Blue Mars* (1997); the Nebula for Best Novel for *Red Mars* (1993) and for Best Novella for "The Blind Geometer" (1986); the World Fantasy Award for Best Novella for "Black Air" (1983); and the John Campbell Memorial Award for *Pacific Edge* (1991).
