Droste - did anybody mention "chocolate"?

Elevators - see "lifts".

Energetic - we had to talk to all of you, didn't we?

Ethnic - snacks ranging from satay to raw herring at booths throughout the city, or dine at the restaurant of your choice.

Experience - we know how to work together smoothly, and how to cater for a large international crowd.

Foreign fans - more international mingling than ever.

Film theatres - 3 film theatres are part of the con complex, seating 3,746.

Floor Space - 110,008 square feet with a variety of meeting rooms under one roof (which does not include the already mentioned film theatres)

Flowers - the trademark of Holland; take home some tulip bulbs.

Gateway - The Hague is the gateway to Europe; judge for yourself.

two hours by train to Brussels, three to the German border, six to the heart of Paris.

Van Gogh paintings - from sunflowers to ravens, an entire museum devoted to his works, in Amsterdam, 50 minutes from The Hague.

Haagsche hopjes - Dutch coffee candy.

Heidelberg - Holland will be exactly 20 years after the last Continental Worldcon in Heidelberg in 1970. Time for another one, we say.

Hospitality - cosy and convenient cafés in the Congress Centre.

Hotels - 1,500 rooms already booked, in all price ranges, easily accessible.

International Court of Justice - a true palace for the eye at 5 minutes walking from the con, but also central to world affairs today.

Isolation - the Congress Centre will be all ours - no other groups to spoil your fun!

John F.Kennedy International Airport - just 6 hours flying from Schiphol International Airport in The Netherlands.

KLM - our official carrier; excellent service and worldwide connections.

Knight's Hall - the 11th century Ceremonial Hall in the middle of the Government complex, at 10 minutes from the con.

Languages - a majority of the Dutch speak excellent English, good German and reasonable French.

Lifts - the Congress Centre is only three floors high, with a central stairway. So, no lift problems. Of course there are many lifts available, see under "Mobility".

Lively - shopping streets throughout the city, including right in the neighborhood of the Netherlands Congress Centre.

Madurodam - the best of Dutch landmarks brought down to scale, 10 minutes from the con. Remember, this is a city that takes several hours to see.

Main Hall - a splendid theatre seating over 2,000; at last you'll be able to see the Masquerade and Hugo Ceremony!

Mobility - The Congress Centre is optimally accessible to the handicapped: from roomy lifts to restrooms.

Museums - two within 1 minute's walk from the con, as a first sample.

North Sea - the famous Scheveningen beaches at a 15 minute walk from the Congress Centre.

Omniversum - a giant 180°screen cinema, just a 1 minute stroll from the con.

Open-minded - for those who want to dress down at the Masquerade.

The Bottom Line: How to Make Holland in 1990 Happen!

Since we first announced our bid, we have seen many gratifying expressions of support. People have helped by leafletting conventions, by serving munchies and drinks at our parties, by guiding us in many strange cities, by being our agents, and by taking pre-supporting memberships with us.

It's beautiful to see how many of you support an International Worldcon bid like ours. But most of you already know that, in the end, there is only one way to make **Holland in 1990** come true.

You *vote* for us at Conspiracy.

How?

First, you have to be a member of Conspiracy, which is the 1987 Worldcon in Brighton, England. You may be either a supporting or an attending member, but you must be a member. If you're not, write to:

Current rates are listed in many SF news magazines and also in some short story magazines. Keep in mind that Conspiracy's mail-in registration will close after 1 August 1987.

Then, as a member, you will receive a Site Selection Ballot from Conspiracy. You can vote with this ballot, either directly in Brighton, or by mail. When you vote, you must also pay a voting fee. The amount still has to be set but will probably be around US\$ 20.00, UK Pounds 15.00 or Dutch f. 40.00. The voting fee automatically gives you a supporting membership in the 1990 Worldcon, no matter who wins.

If you are voting by mail, don't wait with your ballot until the last minute. Mail it first class airmail at your earliest opportunity. Then you can be sure that your vote will be counted. And, again, we need all the help we can get.

We hope to hear from all of you during the Site Selection Ballot counting in Brighton. Let us know you want Holland!




