

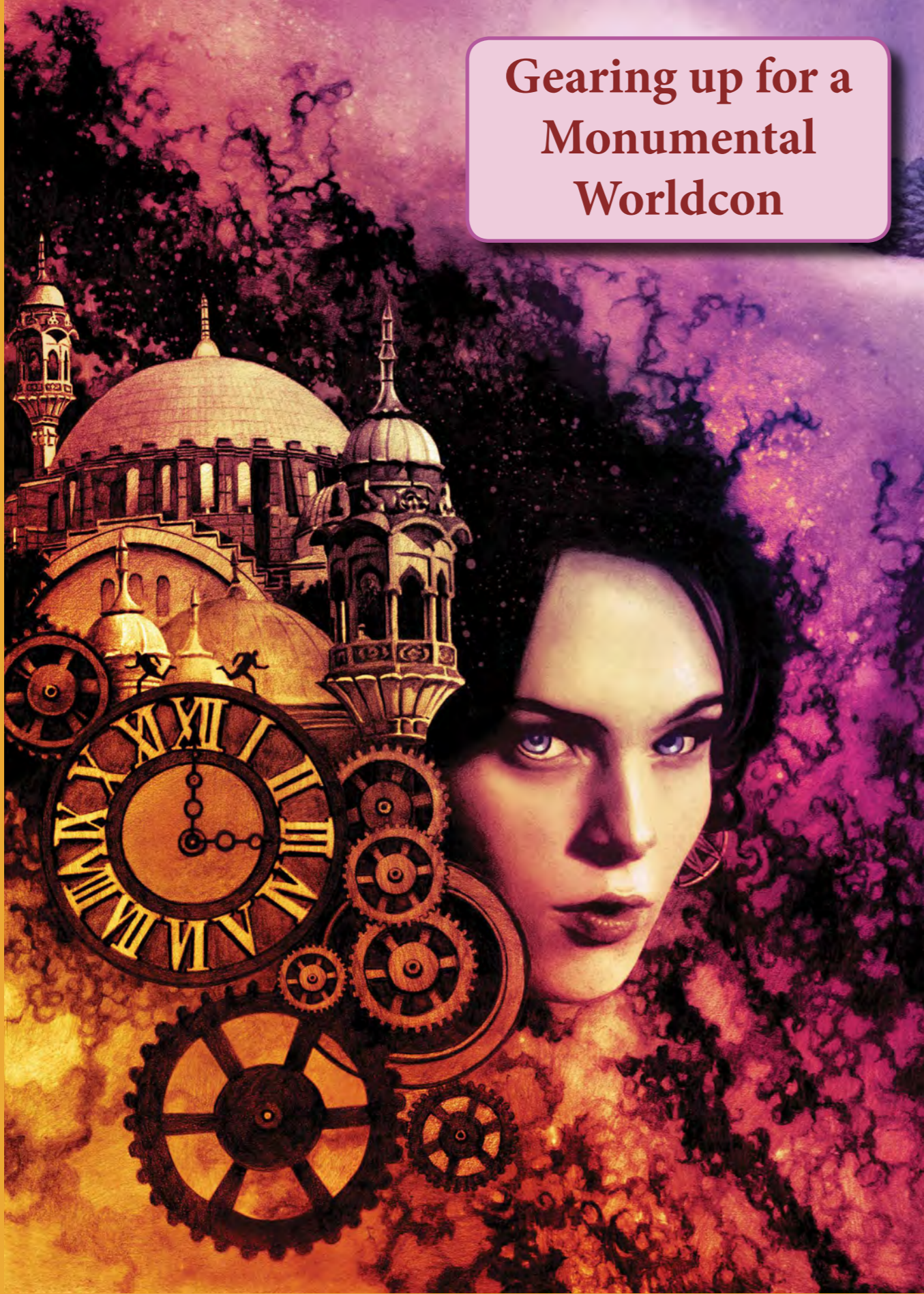

A Message from the Chair

Welcome. *Fáilte!*

It has been a busy time, over thirty of us gathered for our large all weekend face to face committee meeting, just last week, our focus and work on Dublin 2019.

There are a lot of exciting things in the pipeline. It's hard to contain, but I have to be patient, as our Exhibits, Events, and Programme teams work hard on bringing fabulous ideas to fruition. Ideas are wonderful, but we need to make them reality and deliver them!

A week after a successful outreach event at Dublin Comic Con, we went to Worldcon 76 in San Jose and had a fabulous time. I was proud to read out a letter from the President of Ireland, we shared a wonderful promotional video, and our table, party, and efforts went exceptionally well. In August, over 800 people joined Dublin 2019. We have over 3,300 full attending members now.

We now have sold 700 First Worldcon memberships out of 3,300 members. We are very pleased with that. There will be many of you who signed up as subscribers, super friends, or paid for full Membership where Dublin 2019 will also be your first Worldcon. We will have 100 further First Worldcon Resident of Ireland memberships available from Octocon onwards. Welcome to you, anyone who will be making Dublin 2019 their first Worldcon. We cannot wait for you to join us in Dublin for your first Worldcon.

We now have over 600 volunteers, but we need more. Worldcon is a vast undertaking and it only works with volunteers, so please do consider signing up and giving some time of you can. This is more important than it may appear. Worldcons need members to volunteer, even for a short time. We have a wide variety of roles, before and at con, that you may have the perfect skills for and we all can benefit from. Let us know. Fill in our volunteer form online. Join us, your help makes it happen.

We have expanded our convention space. We will be having elements of Dublin 2019 taking place in the Spencer Hotel, 250 metres away, and the Gibson Hotel complex, 850 metres away (or one Luas (tram/trolley) stop.) The WSFS Business Meeting will be in the Gibson. We are also looking at other spaces. The area around the Gibson Hotel has some interesting opportunities for us to expand, and we are actively looking at this.

THIS IS IMPORTANT. We feel that extra programme space would be beneficial, but it would be 850 metres away, and that is non-trivial. In Europe festivals and events are in multiple venues, but Worldcon traditionally has been in one. An important decision for us is where we want to welcome as many fans as possible while also being friendly, accessible and manageable. We think we have identified spaces that will work well, but it is vital that you all understand clearly that we are enlarging our event, and could have a hub of activity at the Gibson Hotel/Point location. Our teams are working hard to ensure that we can make any future expansion options work well, and we will be prompt about letting you know (although I delayed this PR, so that I could get this information to you, I needed to know the extra space identified was suitable and it is, before I could say this to you all, but further processes required - apologies for the delay)

Our Guests of Honour have been busy. Jocelyn Bell Burnell won the Special Breakthrough Prize in Fundamental Physics, some \$3m in prize money and then donated it all, to help women, ethnic minority, and refugee students become physics researchers! Bill Burns won the 2018 Fan Activity Achievement Awards (FAAs) at the Corflu 35 for best fan website, for efanazines.com.

It also gives me great pleasure to let you know that Afua Richardson, will be joining Maeve Clancy and Jim Fitzpatrick as a featured artist. Afua works for Marvel comics and her cover of Shuri #2 written by Nnedi Okorafor has just come out.

Dublin 2019 has been at the forefront of developing how a Worldcon functions, and a new division “Worldcon Fringe”, was initiated, with Maura McHugh and Harvey O’Brien working to expand the scope of our celebration, seeking to partner with a wide variety of third-party venues and organisations, encouraging providers to turn their focus on to the fantastic while we are occurring. It may be as simple as cinemas showing SF films during Dublin 2019, but we want to share our passions as widely as possible. There may be a charge for many of these fringe activities, but we’ve seen the appetite for “more” beyond the convention and based on the success of tours at other Worldcons, making options available from third parties seems desirable.

News of our Fantastic Dublin Fund (FDF) is included in this Progress Report. We’ve been working to expand it in order to help a wider variety of people who would not otherwise be able to afford to attend. I hope that many of you will give to the fund, designed to help people get to and participate in Dublin 2019. We’ve seen how successful this can be with the MexicanX initiative at Worldcon 76 in San José, and we need your support. When one thinks of our GOH Jocelyn Bell Burnell giving some \$3m because ‘..I have this hunch that minority folk bring a fresh angle on things and that is often a very productive thing. In general, a lot of breakthroughs come from left field.’ then we know this feels like the right thing to do.

Hotel information - including prices and booking opening is elsewhere in this PR. Please note the change to Irish Taxes, there is an increase occurring.

While thinking about important dates, the Hugo nomination process will open in the new year and one has to be a member of Dublin 2019 by 31 December 2018 (or have been a member of Worldcon 76) in order to nominate. The PR goes to members, so yay for you, but do encourage and remind those they know might be interested, to take a supporting membership and have their vote!

Finally, Programme are looking for people to be participants. Right now, if you would like to be a participant, you need to say so,

Theatre Call!

At the first Irish WorldCon, in Dublin next year, we’re going to be staging “Jophan!,” Erwin Strauss’ musical adaptation of the great classic of Irish fanwriting, “The Enchanted Duplicator” (a fannish parody of John Donne’s “The Pilgrim’s Progress”) by Walt Willis and Bob Shaw.

Strauss is reaching out to the community for people interested in participating, either on stage, or in the orchestra pit, or wherever. There is no travel budget, so participants will have to already be planning to be attending Dublin 2019. Theater experience is a definite plus, but not necessary.

Please fill in the form mentioned - to get this questionnaire - we cannot send it to people without you signing up. I appreciate your efforts as we work with this.

Exhibits Hall

What it is and how you can get involved

The Exhibits Hall is seeking artists, dealers and creators, scientists, storytellers, and fans. If you'd like to take part, we'd love to hear from you.

For many, the Exhibits Hall is the very heart of a Worldcon, with art, displays, and treasures of all kinds, with creators at work and Worldcon members at play. Read on to find out what's in there for you – and how you can get involved in it yourself.

Art Show

The Art Show will feature paintings, drawings, sculpture, and jewellery exhibited by international and Irish artists. Many of the works in the gallery will be for sale by auction and/or through "buy it now" instant sales. A Print Shop will sell print reproductions, cards, and other smaller items.

The Art Show will incorporate works by Dublin 2019 featured artists Jim Fitzpatrick, Maeve Clancy and Afua Richardson. Other artists already confirmed include Jackie E. Burns, Fangorn, Fred Gambino, Dominika Klimczak, Maurizio Manzieri, and Margaret Walty.

There will be a consolidated shipping service from North America to Dublin to make it easier to transport artworks – details will be available early in 2019. Dealers

The Dealers' Area will be filled with all kinds of merchandise: books, comics, handcrafted jewellery, clothing and accessories, crafts, and toys and games. Dealer tables will be open each day of the convention, and will be a trove of treats, souvenirs, and gifts.

There are details on the web site about table prices, memberships, passes, and other costs. Take a look, and if you have any questions, let us know. We will be providing advance storage for stock so that you will be able to ship stock to us and we will transport it to the CCD for you. Details will be available early in 2019. Registration for Dealer tables will open at the end of November, but if you're interested in taking part, contact us now at dealers@dublin2019.com, and we'll keep you updated.

Displays

The Displays area will include displays and exhibits celebrating the work of our Guests of Honour, about the Hugo Awards, and about fannish things and fandom across the world. There will also be distinctively Irish elements drawn from Irish myth, literature, and art, with science and science fiction from, in, and about Ireland past and present.

Fan Tables

Fan tables are where you can find out about future conventions and bids, and about other fan-related events and organisations. You can ask questions of the organisers, sign up as a member or supporter, and pick up a ribbon or sticker to wear on your convention badge.

If you represent another convention, bid, or fandom-related event or organisation and you'd like to have a table to promote it at Dublin 2019, contact us at fan-tables@dublin2019.com. We expect to finalise table allocations in the months before the convention.

Parties

All official public parties at Dublin 2019 will be hosted in the convention centre (CCD) in function rooms reconfigured from programme spaces to party spaces each evening. The parties will be on the Wicklow Level of the CCD. A maximum of six party spaces will be available on each of the Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights, using the five meeting rooms and the slightly larger ECOCEM room. Each room comes with a limited corkage waiver that allows the party to supply alcoholic drinks up to the value of €250, plus soft drinks and snacks. There is no food (forkage) waiver, so food items will need to be sourced through the CCD caterers. To cover the room resets, CCD support of the parties, and the limited corkage waiver we have for the space, there will be a charge based on the square meterage of the space. The rates (inclusive of taxes) are:

allow two small parties at €175 a night in 39 sqm (420 sq ft) space, but in these cases the amount of alcohol allowed at the party will be €150, and before the split is agreed we will need a matching booking for the other half. As a part of the agreement, all standard alcoholic drinks have to be purchased from the CCD at their cost price. Specialist drinks brought into the CCD should be lock-safed with the CCD caterer. In both cases, they will be delivered to your party space on the night along with ice, lemons, and glasses.

Example prices are:

330ml Bottle of Beer - €1.50

750ml of Basic spirit - €17.50 Gordon Gin,

€16.00 Smirnoff Vodka, €21.50 Jameson's

750ml of wine - €7.50 for the house Red or White

In addition the CCD can provide soft drinks to be delivered to your party at:
330ml Bottle of Soda - €0.60

These prices match, or in some cases better, the prices you'd pay in a local supermarket. To request a party space, email parties@dublin2019.com and we will send you a link to a form to be completed to make your reservation request.

Accommodation

Dublin's general accommodation booking opens on Wednesday 9 January at 14:00 Dublin time, however we will open bookings to those we know have access requirements on Wednesday 5 December at 14:00 (If you have not already done so and will have access requirements please email access@dublin2019.com). In both cases the following rules will apply:

- The full amount of the reservation will be charged on booking
- In most cases this will be fully refundable up to 14:00 (Dublin time) on Friday 10 May.
- And in most cases will then be 50% refundable up to 14:00 (Dublin time) on Monday 10 June.
- After which it will be not refundable., and the convention accommodation bookings will close as any unreserved rooms are handed back to the hotels.

We have selected our accommodation offering based on their rates, and location, with most locations offering a route to the convention centre that involves a walk of less than one kilometre. We have also prioritised our properties so that many are close to the RED LUAS line that is fully accessible. Our current properties are:

- The Spencer Hotel, €240 a night double occupancy, no refunds after 10 May.
- The Clayton Cardiff Lane, €210 a night double occupancy
- The Gibson Hotel, €175 a night double occupancy, 50% refund to 10 June.
- Maldron Pearse Street, €229 a night double occupancy
- Trinity City Hotel, €224 a night double occupancy
- North Star Hotel, €210 a night double occupancy
- Grand Canal Hotel, €180 a night room only
- Buswells Hotel, €196 a night double occupancy
- The Gresham Hotel, €259 a night double occupancy
- Holiday Inn Express City Centre, €209 a night double occupancy

- Academy Plaza Hotel, €214 a night double occupancy
- Jurys Inn Parnell Street, €180 a night double occupancy
- Croke Park Hotel, €205 a night double occupancy
- Jurys Inn Christchurch, €180 a night double occupancy
- Radisson Blu Royal, €290 a night double occupancy
- Herbert Park Hotel, €230 a night double occupancy
- Camden Court Hotel, €225 a night double occupancy
- Hyatt Centric Liberties, €285 a night double occupancy
- The Clayton Ballsbridge, €199 a night double occupancy
- One Room StayCity Apt, €106 per night
- Two Room StayCity Apt, €176 per night
- Trinity College Single Room, €77 a night room only
- Trinity College Twin Room, €123 a night room only

We are working on more hotels and a hotel to our accommodation offering. All rates include all taxes and unless otherwise stated as room only include breakfast for 2 people generally worth €40 if purchased separately. Rates for single occupation are also available, as are rates for triple occupation in the Jury's Inn. In total our accommodation can sleep 3,380 people, which should serve our needs as we know large numbers of you are booking independently through AirBNB, and at budget hotels and suburban hotels outside of the city centre.

Some of you will be interested in Suites and we can offer Junior Suites for an extra €90-€100 per night at the Spencer & Gibson, and deluxe Suites in the Spencer for €150 extra per night. If you wish to reserve a suite please email us at suites@dublin2019.com before the end of 2018, as we cannot guarantee their availability after that.

Our rooms blocks are generally available for check in as early as 13 Aug and check out on

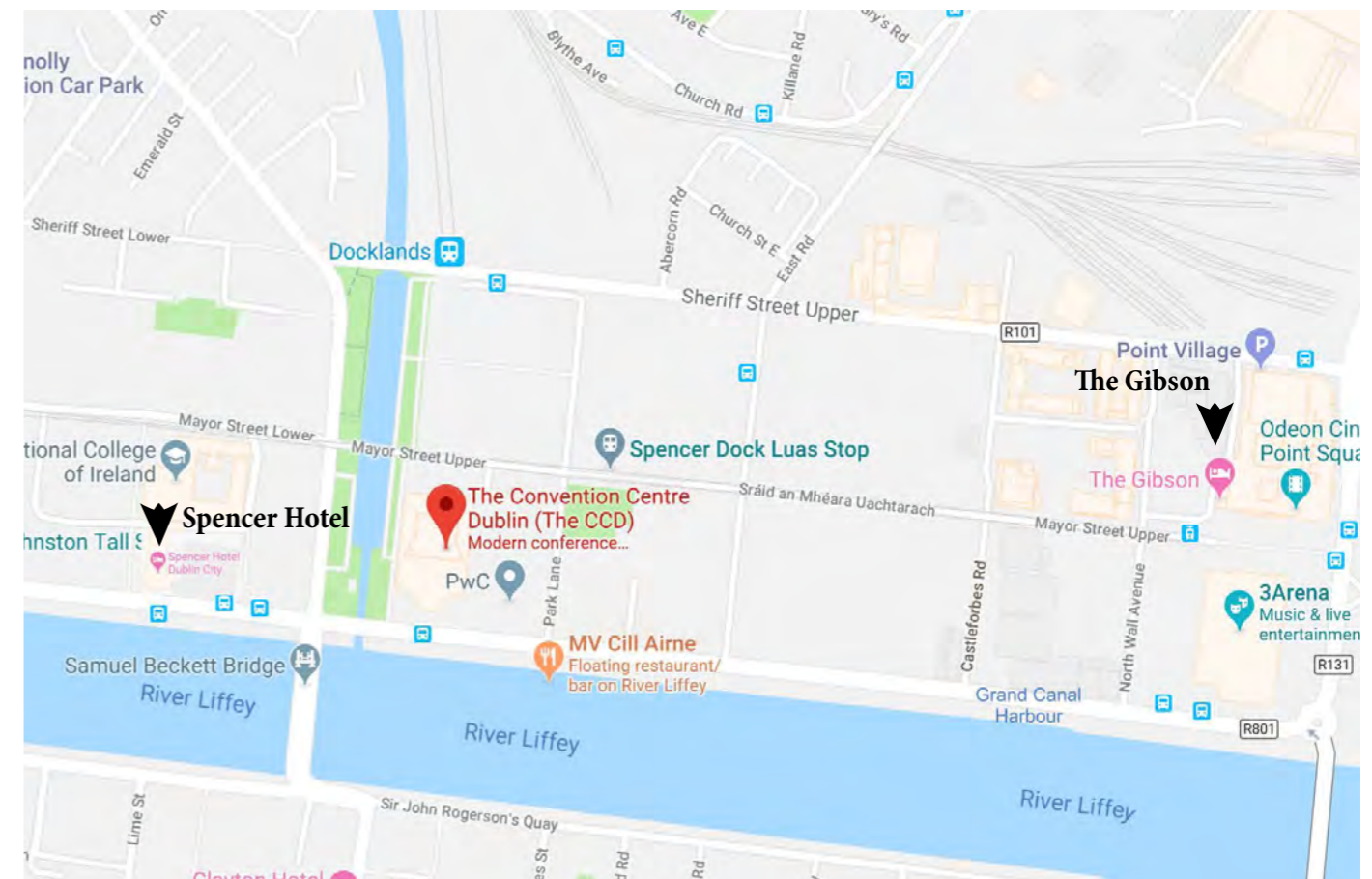
the 21 Aug, but at the Spencer, Hilton Garden Inn, Clayton and Gibson you can check in from 11 Aug.

Please note all parties will be in the CCD, but we do have programme space in the Spencer and Gibson hotels, the latter being the home of the WSFS business meeting.

NOTE: The above rates are from before the recent rise in VAT for Hotels. We do not know, what if any difference this will make to our rates. But at worst we would expect them to rise 4-5%.

Childcare

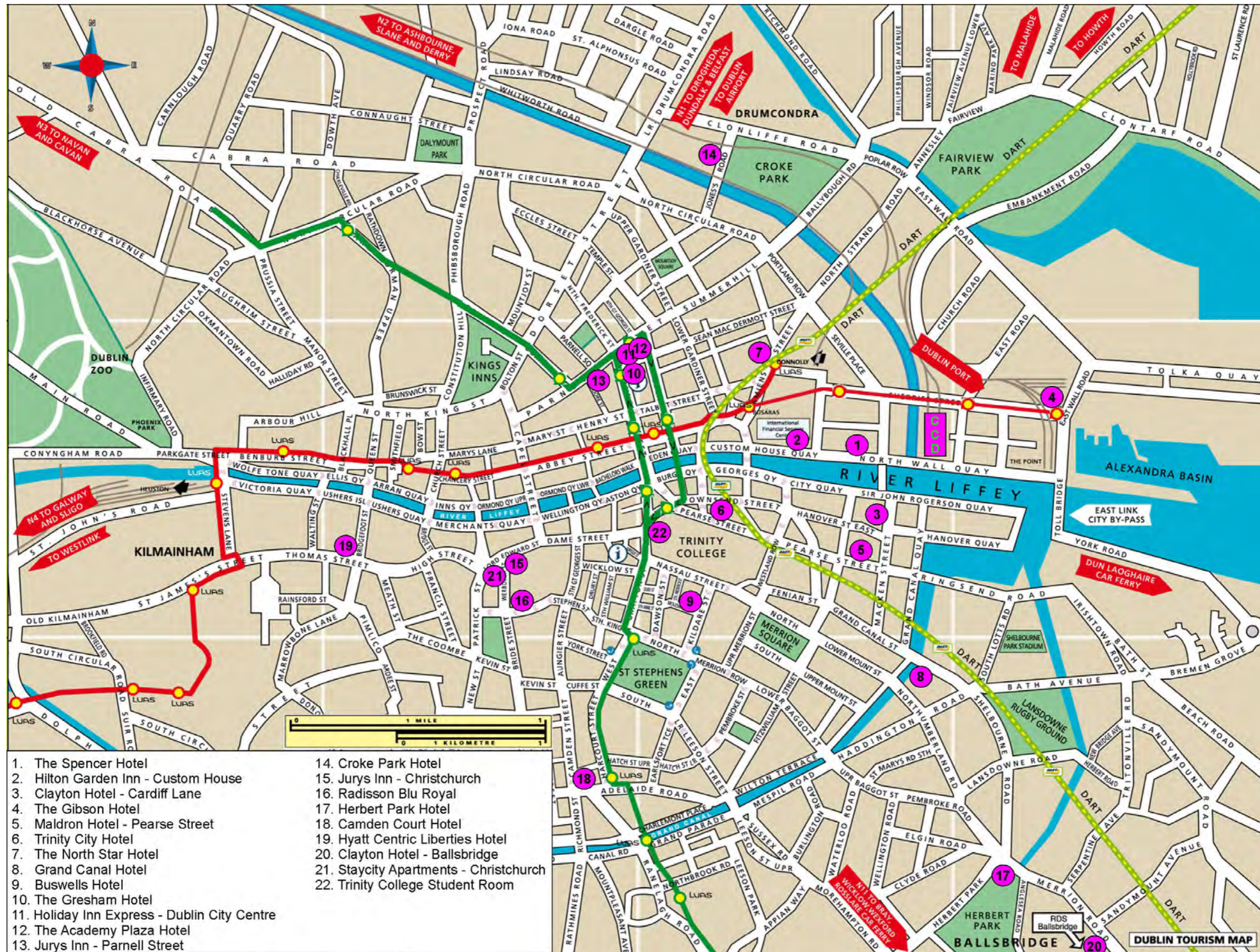
Bringing your little ones to Dublin 2019? We are currently researching childcare vendors and anticipate having details on childcare pricing and availability in early 2019. If you think you might be interested in using childcare services, please let us know - the more we know in advance, the better we can adjust the services we offer to meet your needs. Send an email to childcare@dublin2019.com with the ages of your children, and anything you can tell us about how many or which hours you would expect to use childcare (ie - a few hours every day for programming, just during the Hugo Awards/Masquerade, etc).



There is approximately 850 metres or a half mile between the Convention Centre Dublin and the Gibson Hotel Point Sq. Spencer Dock Luas stop is behind the CCD, and it then one stop to Point Sq, which is exactly where the Gibson is situated. One exits from the front of the CCD, facing the liffey and can then walk to Mayor Street upper which runs east to west, and east to Point Sq.

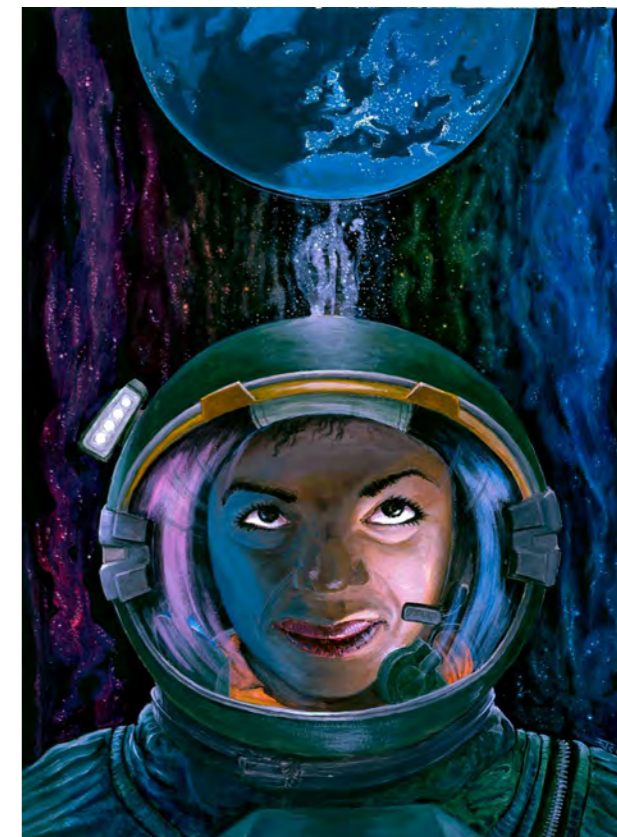

Fantastic Fan Fund

What does it take to be a fantastic Worldcon? Many things, but one of the most important is that we have a diverse array of people participating in Dublin 2019—An Irish Worldcon. 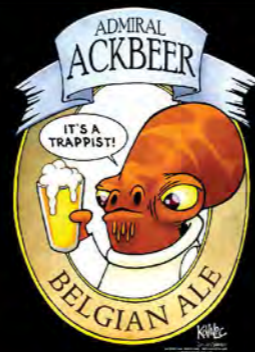

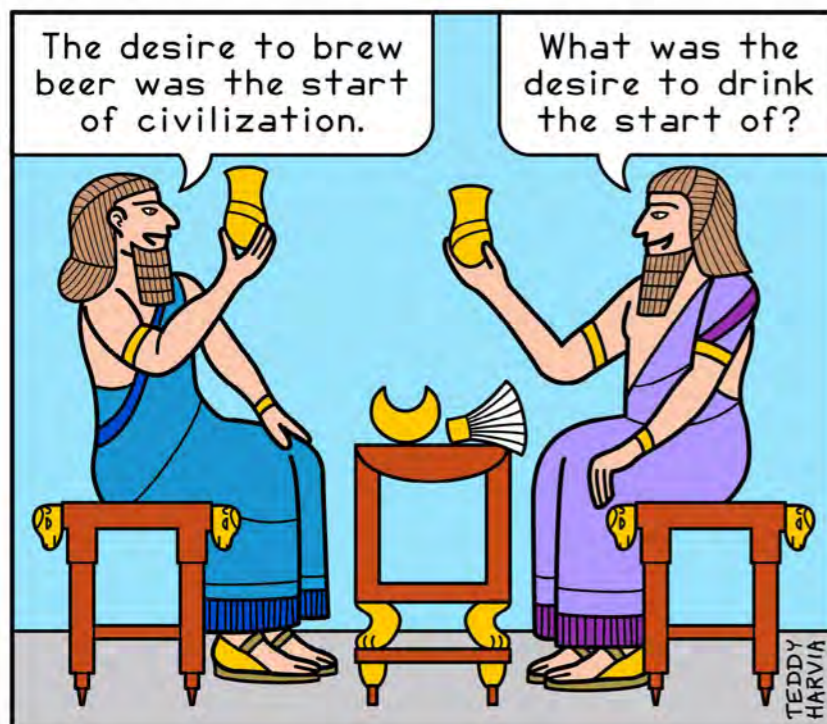
