DISCON III suite you'll have something to eat and drink while you talk about the bid, create some interesting gossip or relax while reading some science fiction.

We would appreciate your views on several issues of concern to Worldcons. A special coupon is enclosed which you may exchange for a copy of the Opinion Poll at the DISCON III party or bid table.

We weren't going to send you mail until after Nolacon, but we couldn't wait to give you the good news. Your pre-supporting membership is now worth \$5.00 towards the cost of attending DISCON III when we win. Now you have one more reason (as if there weren't enough already) to vote D.C. in '92.

We're just one year away from the final voting and things are looking better each day. Before the vote, however, we need campaign workers. If you like to throw parties, become a registered lobbyist. If you are willing to distribute literature at cons you attend, become a ward heeler. Who knows? After the election, you may be rewarded with an office in our administration. A supporting membership costs just \$20; besides being a prerequisite for voting for the site selection, it also entitles you to vote for the Hugo and John W. Campbell awards. Political Favorites will be able to develop a Program Item of their choice (this item will be scheduled at a time and place decided by the Program Chair). (20 Political Favors)

Political Favorites will be invited to join the Committee for the traditional dinner with a Guest of Honor (Dutch treat for the invitee). (25 Political Favors)
