The Sheraton Boston is holding the following for the 2004 MCFI bid for the World Science Fiction Convention.

We are holding a peak night room block of 700 rooms for the weekend of Thursday, Sept 2 through Mon, Sept 6, 2004 (peak Friday/Saturday). The room rates, were the convention to be held in 2000, would be \$129, with a maximum annual increase of 5%. All suites in the hotel are held for the convention.

All of us at the Hynes Convention Center are looking forward to the opportunity of hosting the World Science Fiction Conference ence again. For your review, I have outlined below the exact dates and space being held on a first option basis here at the Hynes.

Exhibit Hall C & D is 74,000 gross square feet/29,600 net square feet and is priced at \$1.25 per net square foot. Therefore, the price for the rental of Exhibit Hall C & D will be \$37,000.00. This includes all move-in, move-out and show times. Meeting rooms 200-210, all pre-function space and show offices are complimentary with the rental of Halls C & D.

The Auditorium, reserved for your general session, will be charged at a flat rate of \$15, 000. Meeting rooms 301 - 313 will be charged at a rate of \$2,950.00 per day.
