

The Worldcon, or World Science Fiction Convention, is the annual convention of the World Science Fiction Society

(WSFS). The five day long event has been held each year since 1939 with the exception of four years during World War II. Locations have included the United States, Canada, Australia, England, Scotland, Germany, and The Netherlands.

Please read the following carefully. General Rules for entry:

1. Films submitted should be in one of the following categories:

- Short Film (under 10 minutes)
- Short Film (under 30 minutes)
- Feature Film (over 30 minutes)

2. All films must be appropriate for all-ages audience. All films will be pre-screened by members of the Film Festival staff.

3. The submission must be accompanied by the official entry form and non-refundable \$20.00 (US) entry fee. Two (2) copies of the submitted film must be sent.

4. To be accepted; submitted films must be completely edited and in their final completed form.

5. Entry fee covers one film and/or trailer by submitter.

6. Films can be live action, animation or a combination of both.

What to send:

• Two (2) copies of your film must be sent. Films should be submitted via mail on DVD to the

address listed below. Please make sure your DVD plays on other computers or DVD players.

- Please include a brief synopsis of your film on a separate sheet of paper not to exceed 50 words, along with a brief bio sheet on filmmakers (director or writer) and one (1) production still for use in any potential publicity. Putting this info on a CD in electronic form is also acceptable.
- All films must be postmarked by the deadline, July 1st, 2011, and be accompanied by a signed entry form, entry fee and any paperwork. Filmmakers with accepted entries will be notified around the beginning of August. The complete schedule of films will appear on the Renovation website, http://renovationsf.org/ and in the onsite film festival program book.

All films will be shown via video projection in a convention center style meeting room, not in a theater. Preferred format for screening is DVD, Region 1.

All scheduling of selected films is at the discretion of the festival programmers. Films will be shown during the Renovation convention hours.

All submitted films cannot be returned. And may be used for promotional purposes.
