BREAKFAST

Breakfast is served in the restaurant and attendees who are residents will be issued with vouchers. Please produce these each morning or you will be charged for the breakfast.

SNACKS AND MEALS

Hot food will be served in the area adjacent to the restaurant, at favourable rates. In the interests of hygiene, we recommend that where possible you should try and avoid bringing take-away foods from outside. Unfinished meals or their used containers fester in the heat more quickly, giving off smells that will make your enjoyment of the convention unpleasant. The management (and the new chef) has tried especially hard to provide a range of inexpensive meals whether you're a carnivore or herbivore. Opening times will be:

THE BAR

The convention bar will be in the Carradale Lounge, which is on the Entresol level of the hotel (see map on the rear page), and will be open from 11.00 - 01.00, daily except Monday when it will close at normal license time. After lam, non-residents who are still at the convention and would like a drink, should ask a committee member or friendly resident attendee to make the purchase on their behalf. Provided that this procedures followed, the hotel will serve drinks until the wee small hours.

The Ailsa Bar, also on the Entresol level, is a public bar and will be used mostly by residents who are not members of the convention. It is generally quieter and the tariff will be the same as the conbar, so if you want a more sedate environment to have a talk with your mates this is the place to be. The Ailsa will be open from 11.00 - 00.00.

THE ART SHOW AND PRINT SHOP

Both are located in the Court Lounge (see map on the rear page), which is on the Entresol level. No smoking, food or drink will be allowed in this area and photography is forbidden unless the permission of the artist has been obtained. If you wish to buy any of the items, please consult the bidding sheet next to each item. Those marked NFS are not for sale. The price quoted is the minimum bid that will e accepted and if none have yet been made, you should start at this price, quoting your name and badge number on the slip. If the bid has started then you should bid slightly higher. These items will be put into the auction and the bidding will start at the highest bid written on the slip. If there have been not bids, the piece will be returned unsold, unless a specific request is made to include it at the end of the auction. The convention take 10% from each item sold except for those sold for charity.

The art show will open at the following times:

The art show will be closed during the Guest of Honour speech on Saturday at 14.00. The print shop will hopefully be used by all the artists displaying in the show, so if there is a piece of work that you like, check to see if there is a print available.

CAR PARKING

Parking is available to all convention members at the N.C.P. adjoining the hotel, accessible from Oswald Street, at rate of £5 per 24hrs. Direct pedestrian access to the Central Station concourse is situated on the 5th level.

DEALERS ROOM

The Dealers Room is situated in the Kintyre Suite (see map on rear page) on the Entresol level. No smoking, drink or food will be allowed in this area. This rule does not apply to the dealers themselves. It will be open at the following times:

The dealers room will be closed during the Guest of Honour speech on Saturday at 14.00.

SECURITY MEASURES AND WEAPONS POLICY

Although thefts are rare at Glasgow conventions, we would like to advise all members to take extra care with their property. Bags, cameras etc., should not be left unattended. Neither the hotel not the committee can take responsibility for items lost or stolen. If you wish to place something temporarily in the sxecure store, contact OPS. If you see anyone acting suspiciously, notify security personnel, OPS or a committee member immediately. Badges must be worn at all times in convention areas and should be worn where it can be easily seen. If you are not wearing your badge, for whatever reason, you will be refused entry into any programme area. If you lose your badge, report to the registration desk or OPS in case it has been handed in. If not, it will be replaced but a charge of 50p will be made for further losses.

The Justice Department is in charge of security operations during the convention. Whilst some of their work is quite essential, some of it is done for fun and for the benefit of our charities. A fining system of 50p per offence will be in force at all times but please remember, it is just for fun! Permits will cost £1 for the first weapon registered and 50p for each additional weapon to the maximum of £5. The Weapons Policy is simple and will be enforced strictly, especially as there will be mundanes in the hotel. It should also be pointed out that the new police laws permit them to arrest you immediately without caution, if you are suspected of carrying a weapon. Any form of weapon, worn for a costume or for fun, whether it is authentic or a replica, must be worn in the convention areas only and in accordance with the following policy:

Bladed weapons must be sheathed and peace bonded at all times. Replica weapons or water pistols may not be loaded at any time. No weapon should be pointed at anyone, waved about in any area of the hotel or worn in public streets. ALL weapons should be registered with the Justice Department: the Judge's decision is final and will be fully supported by the committee. Your permit must be produced if requested, either by a Judge or by a committee member.

Any member who breaches the weapon policy or fails to wear or produce a badge as proof of membership will be fined. Persistent offenders will be asked to leave the convention.

welcome to the ammation stream, where weird and wonderful things (surprisingly, not all of them Japanese) will be screened for your delectation and delight during the convention. Programme items are graded U, A, AA and X.

- U is the same as the current film classification. Everyone is welcome, provided they sit and watch quietly.
- A anyone under the age of 10 yrs must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
- AA 10 15 yr olds must be accompanied by a responsible adult and no-one under the age of 10 yrs will be allowed entry.
- X no-one under the age of 18 yrs will be permitted entry.

This made seem a bit annoying but in the current moral/hypocritical panic, it's best to be on the safe side and in my book, this means parental responsibility. Don't let the U and A classifications put you off, however. Just because something's unsuitable for children doesn't mean it's unsuitable to anyone else! While of course, I would recommend everything on the list, it's customary to list a few favourite items. Herewith are mine:

- AH! MY GODDESS The Norns and diverse other figures from Norse mythology, as you've never seen them before.
- BATMAN: MASK OF PHANTASM probably the best Batman film todate and certainly one
 with the most plot!
- CITY HUNTER: THE MOVIE based (very loosley) on the animation but this has Jackie Chan doing what he does best. Watch out for the 'Street Fighter' sequence.
- GRAVE OF THE FIREFLIES this depiction of life in Japan at the end of World War II, ranks with "ALL QUIET ON THE WESTERN FRONT' and 'SCHINDLER'S LIST'. Not recommended for anyone even remotely prone to depression.
- TOTORO the ultimate feelgood movie. A masterpiece of....... Look, just watch it, okay?!

I hope some of this catches your eye and I look forward to seeing you there or elsewhere throughout the con. And remember, if you've missed something, there's always the request slot on Monday afternoon!

THUNDERBIRDS - DESPERATE INTRUDER. Brains and Tin Tin are on a treasure hunt, so is the Hood. He lies in wait, to collect the treasure and destroy International Rescue in the process.

TERRAHAWKS - ZERO'S FINEST HOUR. The whole of the Terrahawks personnel are out of action. Yungster attempts to follow the Overlander to the Hawk Nest. Zero and his men must handle the situation.

SUNDAY

CAPTAIN SCARLET - SEEK AND DESTROY. Three Angel fighters are destroyed and Mysteronised. Cue the real angels who take on the impostors in a spectacular doglight.

UFO - SURVIVAL. Paul Foster's moonmobile is destroyed by a UFO. Missing, presumed dead, he attempts to make his way back to Moonbase but he is running out of air.
