THE PROGRAMME

General details about the Main and Alternate Programmes were given in the last PR. No major problems appear to have arisen, and we look forward to having all -and, indeed, more- than we promised last time.

MEMBERSHIP

SUPPORTING MEMBERSHIP now costs £4.00; FULL MEMBERSHIP £7.00. There may well be a further at-the-door price rise. DAY MEMBERSHIPS will be available at a prohibitive rate.

Naturally, if you have become a Member prior to the present rates coming into effect these increases will not effect you.

Postal Applications for Membership postmarked after 20 March will not be accepted.

The List is complete to 5 March 1980, and (including some reserved blocks) has about 600 names on it. At the last Convention we ran there were 400 attendees, and only 150 were signed up at this stage; we may well still reach the thousand.

You should note that if your payment for Membership was not of the correct amount then you may have been credited with only SUPPORTING, rather than FULL, Membership. You will be asked to pay any balance at the door.

THERE AND BACK AGAIN: GLASGOW FOR THE UNINITIATED

The Convention Hotel is the Albany Hotel. There are two entrances, one to the Convention Suite (in Douglas Street) and the other to the Hotel proper, in Bothwell Street. If you are not registered at the Albany then you should enter through the Douglas Street doors, where the Albacon Registration Desk will be set up.

Remember, please, that parking immediately outside the Douglas Street entrance is for limited periods only.

If you travel by TRAIN:

Glasgow has two Railway Stations: Queen Street (which handles the East side of the country) and Central Station (which deals with the West). From Queen Street, you should leave the Station and proceed South across George Square onto St Vincent Street. Walk up that street to the junction with Douglas Street ($\frac{1}{4}$ mile) and turn South (left) down the hill to the Albany.

From Central Station you should leave by the vehicular exit in the North-Western corner of the Station (right hand side as you face the ticket barriers from the trains). Walk onto Waterloo Street and after 300 yards the Albany faces you.

If you travel by CAR:

From the East and North: (M8 and A8, and M80 and A80) Join M8 section of the Urban Motorway system at the first available entry heading West. Take slip road marked "City Centre (South)" and turn left onto Castle St; then continue south onto High Street, turn right onto George Street and thence to George Square, from where you should proceed up St Vincent Street to Douglas Street. Watch out for one-way streets. Don't Panic if you do get stuck in a one-way system, as the City Centre is built on a grid pattern and it is always possible to find your way back!

From the South: One mile after the end of the M74 fork left at traffic lights under the bridge and turn onto London Road. Follow same for 5 miles to Glasgow Cross, where you should turn right onto High Street, then left onto George Street. Thereafter, see above.

If you travel by divers unusual means:

Buses arrive from distant places at Buchanan Street Bus Station. Walk down the hill (South) to Queen Street Station. Then proceed as above. By air, get a taxi from the airport; although less than ten miles from town bus and rail services are not particularly good. In any case, if you can afford a Shuttle seat (soon to rival NASA's for cost) you won't be beggared by a mere taxi fare.

If you get totally lost:

Call the Committee at the Hotel (tel (041) 248 2656).

Car Parks:

NCP Multis on Montrose Street, Mitchell Street, Waterloo Street, Douglas Street (Anderston Centre) and various other locations. Abundant free areas behind offices, and many parking meters. The Albany has only a small car park, and car keys MUST be deposited with the porters.

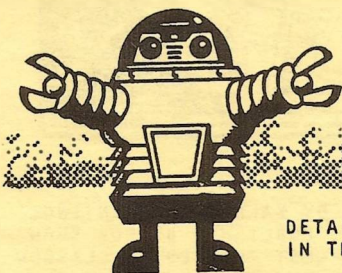
THE SCOTTISH SPACE SOCIETY

Various other groups will also help our display and lectures at the Convention. These include ISTR (UK), The United States Space Educational Association and the European Space Promotion Organisation.

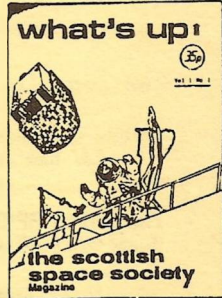
