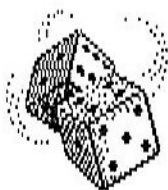

## MORE ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

As mentioned in the introduction, vampires will have an integral role in the programme but this does not mean ALBACON 94 will be a horror con. As before, the committee will try and cram in so much science fiction into four days, that your head will spin! Video rooms will offer you the difficult choice of watching Star Trek, Deep Space 9, Dr Who, Gerry Anderson classics, Red Dwarf, Blake's 7, Japanese animation and courtesy of the Scottish Society of Fantastic Films, a wide range of rare films and video shows.

As well as the big events, like guest talks, the masquerade and films, the main and alternative programme streams will have various panels, discussions, silly games, quizzes and much more. We are currently negotiating our author guest: an announcement will be made in the next progress report.

The convention starts on Friday with the video rooms opening at 10am and the main/alternate programmes opening at 2pm. Most convention areas will be accessible for 24hrs, the exceptions being, naturally, the dealer's room, art show and ASTRA exhibit. The convention will run through to Monday with the majority of programmes closing by 10pm.

## HOW TO REGISTER FOR THE CONVENTION

Memberships are available in two categories. Full attending membership entitles the member to receive all convention publications and to attend the convention itself. Supporting membership entitles the member to receive the progress reports but does not permit entrance to the convention until the balance is paid. The conversion rate is based on the rate at the time of taking out an supporting membership and can be paid either before or on arrival at the convention.

## DEALER'S ROOM INFORMATION

As in previous years, there will be a large dealer's room offering the latest in books, comics and magazines. Other items on sale will be posters, models, jewellery and other paraphernalia.

All bookings will be on a "first come, first served" basis and a maximum of 6 tables per booking.

## WEAPONS POLICY

The Justice Department will be running the convention security again and will be applying their usual weapons policy. This means you present any weapon you like to the duty judge for approval and purchase a permit, with the proceeds going to the con charity..

There will be some restrictions on what you can bring or do. These will be:

ALL bladed weapons must be peace bonded. Replicas and water pistols may not be loaded at any time. Weapons should not be pointed at anyone. The Judges' decision is final as to what comprises a weapon. Breaches of policy will result in the revoking of your licence and the confiscation of your toys until the end of the con.

## THE CENTRAL HOTEL: ALL YOU WANTED TO KNOW BUT WERE AFRAID TO ASK!

Those of you who have been to previous ALBACONS will be familiar with the layout of the hotel. A well-known landmark in the centre of the city, its Victorian facade and function room interiors have been preserved and recent renovation have added to its character. It is, of course, ideally placed for commuters as it was originally built as a railway hotel, and today the rear entrance opens directly into the Central Station concourse which is good news for fans travelling from the South. There is a bus link for those arriving at Queen Street Station and if you want to see some of the sights of Glasgow, most of the bus routes run past the hotel.

All the rooms in the hotel have en suite bathrooms, colour television and in-house movies, tea/coffee making facilities and excellent room services if needed. The Entresol restaurant has an excellent carvery and à la Carte menu but it is important to give good notice of any special dietary needs, which you can indicate in the hotel booking form. New to the hotel, is the leisure club, located in the basement, and is also accessible from Hope Street. All facilities are available to hotel residents and children **MUST** be accompanied by an adult. It is open Mon-Fri from 7am - 9pm and weekends from 8am - 8pm. Facilities include:

- swimming pool with jet steam
- comprehensive "Pulstar" and "Life Fitness" gymnasium
- Turkish steam room
- sunbed salon
- relaxing whirlpool spa
- dry Finnish sauna
- fully qualified staff for professional fitness assessment and planning of exercise programme.

The committee will be discussing the tariff for the con bars and the provision of inexpensive snacks during the convention which will be advertised in later progress reports.

To get the most from ALBACON 94 we recommend attendees to stay at the convention hotel, that way you won't miss anything and you won't have to worry about getting home in the middle of the night (or early in the morning). Needless to say, to make this more attractive to you, we have secured extremely reasonable room rates that I doubt can be matched by any other convention.

To make it easier for some to cover accommodation costs, the committee has decided to offer the option of a payment scheme. A £10 deposit payable to the Central Hotel **MUST** be made with each booking whether you are using the payment scheme or not. It is non-refundable but will secure your booking. To participate in the scheme, you must send a minimum of £10 per month to the convention address (the last postal payment should be sent before Friday 14th October 1994). Immediately before the convention, or after full payment has been made, the money will be transferred to the hotel. In the event of a cancellation, repayment will be made within one month after the last day of the convention. This payment scheme is not compulsory but if you wish to use this option, please indicate so on your hotel booking form which is available from the convention address.

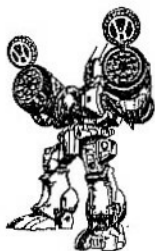
**ATTENTION MASQUERADERS!**

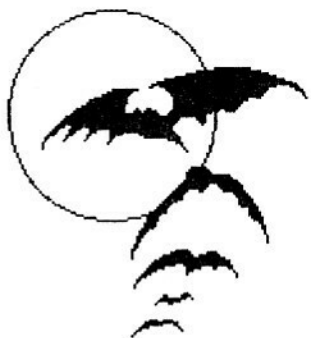
# DEAD BY DAWN
