FUTURESHOCK SPONSORS MASQUERADERS



Neil Craig of FUTURESHOCK BOOKS & COMICS has generously donated £30 in vouchers, which can be used either at the convention or the shop in Byres Road, Glasgow. The offer has been made to encourage costumers not only to take part in the masquerade but to also wear hall costumes, which always add extra color to the convention (and keeps the press happy). The vouchers will be awarded to the Best of Show winner and the two best Hall costumes of the convention. The committee are extremely grateful for this offer. Those whose costume includes weaponry, please note that all weaponry **MUST** be presented to the Justice Department for approval and a permit.

SECURITY STATEMENT

The Justice Department will be responsible for implementing security measures during the convention weekend, including Thursday 20th October and Tuesday 25th October.

Their two most important duties will be:

- Ensuring that attendees wear a badge visibly in any area of the convention.
- Enforcing the following weapons policy:

ALL bladed weapons must be peace bonded. Replicas and water pistols may not be loaded at any time. Weapons should not be pointed at anyone. Breaches of policy will result in your license being revoked and your toys confiscated. The Judge's decision, as to weapon classification and imposing a fine, is final.

In both these circumstances, the Judge's decision will be fully supported by the committee. **ANY** attendee who does not adhere to either of these convention policies or persistently challenges them, risks being expelled from the convention.

These security measures have been drawn up for the benefit of all parties involved including attendees. The committee cannot be held responsible for the loss of personal items such as handbags, wallets etc., but access to temporarily store valuable belongings in the convention's secure store will be provided. All money raised from fines and permit applications will be donated to the convention charities - **SPEAKING BOOKS FOR THE BLIND** and **THE SCOTTISH CHILDRENS HOSPICE APPEAL**.

IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR ALL TRADERS USING THE DEALERS ROOM

For those of you who have booked tables but have not yet paid for a membership, please remember that the rate will be increased to £30 after April, which will affect the amount of discount you will be entitled to. In addition, if you are intending to have helpers or a partner to assist you, their name(s) must be notified to the membership secretary NO LATER THAN Friday 14th October.

Dealers badges will differ from the standard convention badge: instead of two separate badges, all those who will be on duty in the dealers room, at any time, will have one badge showing their name and status. This change in practice is for security purposes and the committee will be most grateful for your full co-operation.

HOTEL RESERVATIONS

Convention room rates are fully inclusive of V.A.T. and breakfast, as well as being the most competitive. The rooms, per person/per night, are priced as follows:

SINGLE, TWIN or DOUBLE - £20. TRIPLE - £19. QUAD - £17

Please remember that a minimum deposit of £10 is required per booking. Cheques/Postal Orders should be made payable to the Central Hotel and NOT to the convention! An SAE should also be enclosed if you require a receipt for your deposit, which will be sent to you by the hotel when your booking has been processed. (Triple and quad rooms are extremely limited, so if you are considering either, book as soon as possible.)

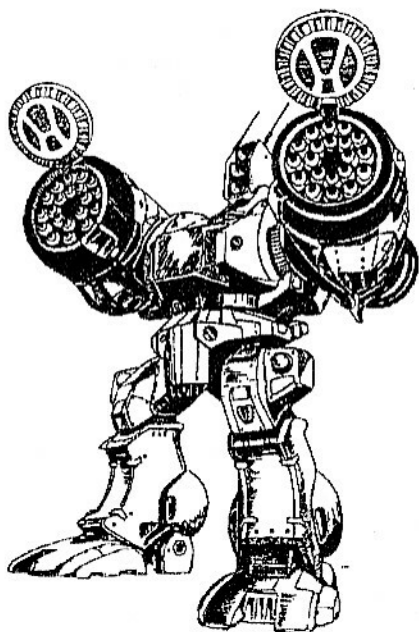
ADVERTISING IN FUTURE PUBLICATIONS

The hotel will keep your work in a safe area until the committee transfers to the operations room at the hotel on Thursday 20th October. Transportation of artwork to the convention is the responsibility of the individual artist.
