

Progress Report 2


Welcome to PR2 for Fourplay, the 4th British filk con. The convention is on the weekend of 31st January to 2nd February 1992. The location is the Victoria Park Hotel, Lichfield Street, Wolverhampton. The room rate is £27 per person per night and attending membership is currently £18 for adults (rising to £20 on the door) and £1 per head for soft toys/children. The deadline for postal memberships is 19th January. Our Guests of Honour are going to be Cynthia McQuillin, Jane Robinson and Colin Fine.

The Hotel

How to get there
