



Space Leopard Keyring

Hi Space Travellers,

Show your love for the Space Leopards and make a keyring. It will stop any face eating at the ports.

This pattern uses UK terminology

Conversion Table

ENGLISH STITCH NAME	AMERICAN STITCH NAME
DC = Double Crochet	SC = Single Crochet
HTR = Half Treble	HDC = Half Double Crochet
TR = Treble	DC = Double Crochet
DTR = Double Treble	TR = Treble
TRTR = Triple Treble	DTR = Treble

You can use any size yarn and its corresponding hook, it will just come out larger or smaller.

To make this one. You will need :

- 4 mm hook
- Blunt needle to sew and sewing needle for sequins
- Blue dk yarn
- White or cream dk yarn
- Tiny amount of black dk for mouth
- Sequins - 2 8mm gold, 2 6mm black for eyes, 8mm black for nose

Head

1. Make a magic ring as per the basic instructions on the other sheet
2. Dc 6 into the magic ring 6
3. (2dc in each) x6 12
4. (dc1, 2dc in next) x6 18
5. (dc2, 2dc in next) x6 24
6. Chain 4, in second from hook, dc1, then in next htr1, in last tr1, skip 2 stitches on the round and dc into next (this forms the first ear)
7. We are going to attach the keyring now. Put the hook through the next stitch and then the keyring, it may be a tight squeeze but you can do it! Then complete the stitch pulling back through both the stitch and the keyring.
8. dc1, then repeat row 6 to make another ear.
9. Slst to fasten. Sew in the end

Body, arms and legs

1. Count three stitches from the last ear. In fourth, attach the white or cream yarn and dc 10 round the head (this forms the neck helmet piece.) 10
2. Chain 1, turn, dc10 10
3. Chain 1, turn slst 2, dc6 6
4. We are going to make the arm and hand now:
 - a. Turn dc6, chain 10. Starting with the second chain, dc3 back along the chain. (This forms the first finger).
 - b. Chain 4. Starting with the second chain, dc3 back along the chain.
 - c. Chain 4. Starting with the second chain, dc3 back along the chain.
5. Chain 1, put your hook into the last finger and pull up the yarn, keep it on the hook, repeat for the two other fingers, now yarn over and pull through all loops on the hook.
6. Dc6 back down the main chain. (the arm and hand are now complete.)
7. Repeat row 4 (no need to turn) and 5 to make the other arm.
8. Dc6 along the body. Turn. repeat this 4 more times 6
9. We are now going to make the legs
 - a. Chain 11, starting at the second chain from hook, dc4 back along the chain, turn, dc 4, turn dc4.
 - b. Dc 1 in the end of the three rows made by row a. Then dc 6 back up the main chain.
 - c. Dc1 into next stitch on the body (this completes the first leg)
10. Slst to fasten. Sew in the ends.

Congratulations! You now have your space leopard keyring.
