# ConSept:Un7con

Welcome to the first Progress Report of ConSept:Un7con\* Science Fiction Convention. In this report you will find details of the convention, its location, the committee and a list of those who have already signed up as members. It is also being sent to all who were members of Unicon 6 (Camcon). However to receive further issues people must be members of ConSept:Un7con.

#### WHEN

The convention will take place on the 8th,9th & 10th of August 1986. Starting early on the Friday evening and finishing late Sunday night.

#### WHERE

The convention will be located at the University of Surrey; in Guildford. Which is about thirty miles south west of London and has been around from about the year 975. The University is about a mile from the centre of town, 10 minutes walk from the railway station and has its own exit from the A3.

Food provided on campus ranges from bar snacks to three course meals, all at very reasonable rates. We have arranged with the diocesan authorities for a cathedral to be provided on site for the benifit of Sunday worshippers.

Although we have not finalised room rates yet, we expect them to be considerably cheaper than last year.

# Lemon Devil's Food Cake.

Cake:	3 tbs cocoa 3 ounces plain flour 1/4 pint of milk 1 tsp vanilla essence 3 egg whites beaten til	3 egg yolks 3 tbs water 1 pinch salt 1/4 1b of butter 11 stiff	3 level tbs white sugar 1 ounce cornflour 1 level tsp baking soda 1/2 1b of brown sugar
Combin	e cocoa, white sugar	and water in the fit inside one and	top of a double saucepa other) and cook over wate

Combine cocoa, white sugar and water in the top of a double saucepan (I have two saucepans which fit inside one another) and cook over water (in the bottom saucepan), stirring until smooth and thick. Stir in milk and vanilla essence; blend well and set aside to cool.

Cream butter and brown sugar. Beat in egg yolks one at a time; then beat in chocolate mixture. Sift flour and cornflour three times with baking soda and salt, and beat into the cake mixture (since I used a food processor, I didn't bother too much with the mechanics of mixing the ingredients). Fold in egg whites. Pour the mixture into cake tins and bake for 30 to 35 minutes in a slow oven (350F, gas mark 3). (This last bit is where I diverged markedly from the recipe. After 45 minutes the mixture was still fluid, and I eventually took it out after about 1½ hours. This may mean that my oven is screwed-up, or the recipe may be wrong. Use your own judgement).

Cream sugar and softened butter. Add grated lemon rind & juice, and Grand Marnier, to taste. Beat until smooth and creamy. Spread between layers and cover cake. (Note that the proportions given are almost certainly wrong — the icing tastes far too strongly of butter. What I did was to add about 1/4 lb of butter to start with and then work by taste. It makes a lot of icing. If the lemons are large, the mixture can become too runny).

## WHAT

Obviously we have begun to think about programme items, and already have a few ideas. Although it is still very early for anything to be firm.
