## Executive Summary

Sunset Station occupies most of a very large block with Strip Malls and businesses on most sides. Sunset Road or Warm Springs Road lead to the property. Sunset Road, on the eastern side, has the main entrance. Warm Springs, on the western side, is the back door. Stephanie Street borders on the north and Marks is on the southern side.

The entrance off of Marks is closest to the 21-storey Hotel Tower, which dominates the entire area and is a very viable landmark. The following driving instructions are all about getting you to Sunset or Warm Springs then to Marks so you can check in to claim your room.

## What's Next for *Glitter*?

A few fans thought that *Glitter* #58 would be the Grand Finale. As this very fanzine proves, that assumption was incorrect.

It would be equally erroneous to believe that #59 will wind up the run.

*The Corflu Glitter Program Book* will be *Glitter* #60, which will retain the Friday schedule.

# Getting to Corflu Glitter

## From Southern California / I-15

As you cross the Vegas Valley, there are a number of choices. The most logical is the Beltway (215) towards Henderson which is East of the I-15. At the large interchange, switch to the North-bound Highway 515 which also incorporates US Hwy. 93 and 95 at that point. Going straight leads to downtown Henderson and then Boulder Highway. A left onto Boulder highway can get you to either Warm Springs or Sunset and then to the hotel. If you go South on the 515/93/95, you'll visit Boulder City, which is nice but not where you're trying to go.

On the North-bound 515/93/95, turn left at the Sunset Road exit. The next light is Marks Street. Turn left then right at the next light.

## From Northern Nevada / Utah

Coming from northern Nevada on US 95 or US 93 will eventually allow you change to Highway 515, going southbound. Get off at Sunset Road, turn right, get over to the left and turn at Marks Street. Then go to the next traffic light and turn right into the property. Once I-15 reaches just north of downtown Las Vegas follow the signs to the 515/93/95 and proceed to Sunset Road Exit.

## From Arizona and the pointy tip of Nevada

You'll be on either US 93 from Arizona or US 95 from far southern Nevada and they merge just west of Boulder City. You then climb over Railroad Pass and join the 515 arriving in due course at Sunset Road and again you turn left going to Marks Street, then to the light and turn right to Sunset Station.

## A Note on Why the Southerly Entrance to Sunset Station

The South entrance is closer to check in and the hotel rooms. It avoids walking through the Casino. Inside, facing the Café, to the right, at the edge of the casino, is the check-in desk. The Tower elevator lobby is left. You can't go above the second floor without your room key as you have to insert it into the elevator control panel. The short hallway to the right of the Café leads to a separate elevator and stairway to the Sunset Room.

## From the Airport to Sunset Station in less than 90 days.

Since the paid shuttle service's don't go to Sunset Station or any other casinos that far off the strip you have four choices if you don't use or can't use the free shuttle provided by Sunset Station.

## Taxis

These leave from the east side of the baggage claim area (exits 1-4)

and start at \$20 plus tip. Let them know when you get in if you're going to use a credit card and that they should take Russell Road rather than the Freeway. Not all cabs take credit cards and taking the Freeway will cost a lot more. Taxis are also available at the Car Rental Center which you can reach via the free shuttle from the airport.

### **Rent-a-Car**

There are no rental company shuttles from McCarran, instead you take a free shuttle to an off airport location. Use exits 10 & 11 from the baggage claim area to reach the shuttles. Once you've picked up your car it's dead simple to reach the Hotel. You can turn left or you can turn right, left will take you to Sunset Road and turning right will take you Warm Springs Road.

The road from the Car Rental Center, Gillespie Street, dead ends in Sunset Road which runs along the south side of the Airport. Just turn right and stay on Sunset Road all the way to the Hotel. While there are three entrances off Sunset Road to the hotel, you'll want to keep on till Marks Street ( look for the sign for the Gold Rush Casino on the corner) then turn right on Marks Street. Continue to the next light, turn right again and the south entrance to Sunset Station will be dead ahead.

If you choose right instead of left when leaving the Car Rental Center you'll go less than a block to Warm Springs Road. Move to the left so you can get in the left hand turn lane at the light. Then just stay on Warm Springs in till you reach Marks Street. This will be a turn to the left. When you reach the next light after turning onto Marks Street turn left again then go straight ahead to the south entrance to the hotel. Before you get to Marks there will be an entrance to Sunset Station and it's parking garage marked by a large sign, but you will be closer to the hotel check in by continuing to Marks Street.

### **Airport Pickup by a friend**

Your friend should know how, so there's no need to go into details here, except to say you can also take the free shuttle to the Car Rental Center and get picked up there which might be easier for the friend.

### **Public Transit**

Is limited but cheap compared to other ways, just a total of \$4.00 each way. You need to take the #109 bus to the South Strip Transit Center and then take the #212 bus down Sunset Road to the Hotel. Exact fare is required and each segment is \$2.00. The Bus Stop is on Level Zero, the level below baggage claim. The #109 runs up to three times an hour and the #212 twice an hour. Google transit shows taking the #109, then #212 as the best connection. The #217 runs down Warm Springs, but is only hourly service and would mean a much much longer walk to check in.
