Smoking at Corflu Glitter

Sunset Station Hotel & Casino tries to please both smokers and those who prefer to avoid the known danger of secondary smoke.

To summarize the situation, there of the four floors in the building that holds our meeting rooms and guests rooms are 100% non-smoking. That includes the floor on which Corflu Glitter's main Con suite is located. The smoking con suite, which will also have a supply of drinks and snacks, is on the smoking floor. (Reminder: the number of smoking guest rooms is limited. Reserve now to avoid later disappointment.)

It is possible to move between the hotel's main building and the one assigned to us without going through any smoking area. This may come in handy for those going to one of the hotel's many eateries. There is a shortcut through a well-ventilated and semi-open part of the casino if you can withstand a faint whiff of nicotine.

The bowling area is non-smoking, but there's a bar immediately behind the lanes where competitors and spectators can smoke while they drink.
