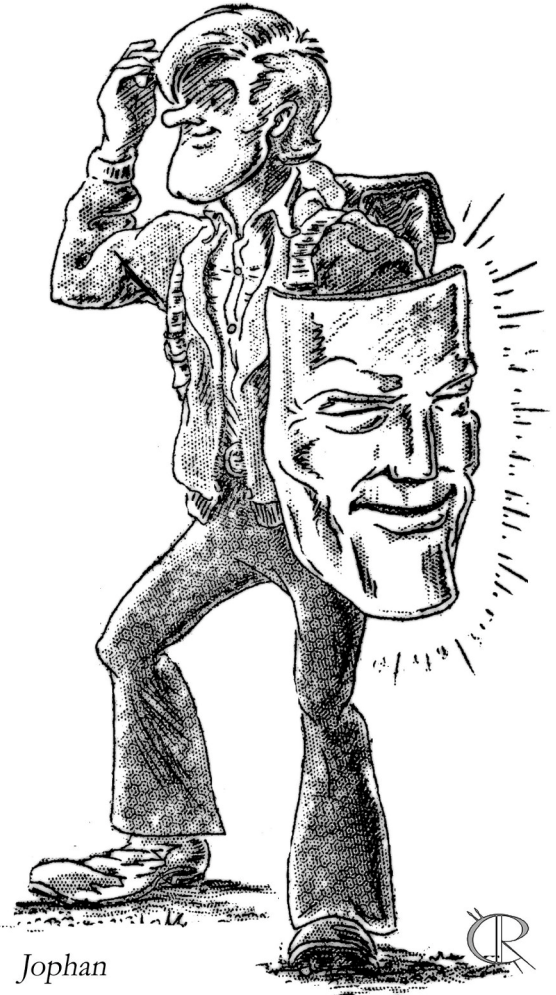
We've received inquiries about Corflu Silver merchandise.

wings of the “WAW and the Crew in ‘62” special fund. As things turned out, Terry gave Willis more than the cash equivalent and kept the cups as a souvenir.

He kept them for nearly a decade before donating the cups and a heap of pennies to the Bob Shaw Fund. When the BNF and professional SF author visited Brooklyn before heading to Boston for the 1971 Noreascon, BoSh didn’t react want the pennies, so I (Arnie) gave him paper money – and kept the jars and their contents.
