The 61-year-old apparently died of a heart attack in the early hour of Sunday, September 4 in the Michigan home he shared with wife Laurie Kunkel.

The first of three memorials was held in Michigan on September 8. There will be additional Memorials in New York and Las Vegas. More specifics next week.

Hotel Extends Convention Rates

Trufandom now has broader shoulders to go with its Cosmic Mind and Broad Mental Horizons. "Shoulder" is hotel jargon for room rates before and after a convention.

Corflu Glitter Chairman Joyce Katz has negotiated an extension of the rock-bottom con room rates, including waiver of the resort fee, with Sunset Station. Those obtaining accommodations using the Corflu Glitter group code (*see the "Vital Information" box below*) are now guaranteed convention rates starting on the Monday night preceding the con and ending the Tuesday night after Corflu. It's possible that Corflu guests with reservations may be able to arrange low rates beyond those days.

This is also a reminder that availability, especially of smoking rooms, is limited. Early reservations are recommended.
