The Corflu Glitter Hotel

Corflu Glitter has selected the beautiful and luxurious Sunset Station Hotel-Casino in Henderson, NV, which shares the Vegas Valley and is adjacent to it.

Accommodations: All guest rooms are located in a four-story building that also contains the meeting rooms. Double occupancy rooms are available with two queen-size beds or one king-size bed. Up to two additional people can stay in a guest room at the additional cost of \$15 per extra person per day.

Room rates are \$55 Sunday through Thursday, \$85 for Friday and Saturday nights. The hotel has agreed to give fans booking with the Corflu Glitter group code convention rates from the Tuesday before the con until the Wednesday after it. Direct contact between guest and hotel may make further extensions possible.

Amenities: Sunset Station has waived the \$12.99-a-day "amenities fee" for Corflu Glitter guests, which means that fans will get a lot of extras at no additional cost. Perks include free shuttle to and from the airport, an Internet hotspot, an In-room coffee maker and access to the health center, pool and other hotel facilities.

<u>Smoking and Non-smoking rooms</u>: Sunset Station has blocked three floors of non-smoking rooms and one floor of smoking rooms. Booking early is strongly advised, especially if you want one of the smoking rooms.

Restaurants: Sunset Station has an array of restaurants. The Grand Café is 24/7 with a big menu, pleasant service and pretty good food. The Sonoma Cellars Steakhouse, Capri Italian Ristorante and Guadalajara (Southwest) are the main restaurants. Sunset Station also has the well-regarded Feast buffet, and a Wings & Things next to the Race and Sports book.

The Sunset Station Food Court has a Fatburger, Starbucks, Viva Salsa, Subway, Panda Express, Sbarro and Ben & Jerry's. And if you just don't want to leave your room, there's round-the-clock room service, too.

Corflu Glitter, as befits a convention by and for Trufans, has ambitious publishing plans.

This is what we've got on the schedule:

Corflu Glitter Program Book. This small, printed publication will carry the full schedule of programming and special events.

Food & Sightseeing Guide. Brenda Dupont, with the able assistance of Linda Bushyager, is producing a guide to Las Vegas restaurants and attractions. Each entry will provide relevant information, including pricing, location and a no-holds-barred comment. The Guide will be sent electronically to all members prior to the convention and will also be available in printed form at Corflu.

Faned's Choice. This is a new anthology series featuring outstanding selections from the year's best fanzines, as chosen by those fanzines' editors. **Faned's Choice: 2010** should be available in December 2011. **Faned's Choice: 2011** is expected to be available in August, 2012.

The Vegas Fandom Anthology. JoHn Hardin is editing an anthology of some of the best fanwriting done by Las Vegas fans in conjunction wit the Las Vegas Fandom Reunion. Contributors will include Ken Forman, Marc Cram, Aileen Forman, Teresa Cochran, James Taylor, JoHn Hardin, Jacq Monahan, Brenda Dupont, Ross Chamberlain, Joyce Katz and me (Arnie).

The Ross Chamberlain Treasury. Arnie Katz is editing a collection of some of Ross Chamberlain's best fannish and stfnal artwork. This is part of the New York Fandom Reunion and will debut in printed form at the Saturday party.

The 2012 FAAn Awards Book. The top finishers in each category of the 2012 Fan Activity Achievement Awards will be announced at the Corflu Glitter banquet.
