The association between the popular fan couple and Corflu goes back to its earliest years. Dan and Lynn were prominent member of the committee that staged the third Corflu in Tyson Corners, VA.

Says Dan of his adopted hometown: "Portland will be an excellent site for Corflu. There are more bookstores, brew pubs, tattoo parlors, and strip clubs in Portland, per capita, than anywhere else in the country. We have no sales tax, beer, no pump gas stations, beer, a mostly free train/trolley system that will allow attendees to fully explore the city without a car, beer, and a food cart revolution that has recently been voted 'the best street food in the world.'

Dan notes that, at this early date, all the details are yet to be determined. He and Lynn plan to be ready with a detailed presentation at the Corflu Glitter banquet.
