Corflu Glitter Plans NY Fandom Reunion

These three groups, with their overlapping memberships, shaped Fanzine Fandom in the 1960's and 1970's. "Las Vegas Fandom owes a lot to those New York fan clubs," says Joyce Katz, chairman of Corflu Glitter and High Priestess of Fandom. "Our club, the Vegrants, is modeled on Fanoclasts and former New York fans did a lot to help create today's Las Vegas Fandom."

Plans parallel those for the Las Vegas Fandom Reunion. The NY Fandom survivors will host the huge Saturday Night bash in the main con suite and there'll be a New York Fandom memories panel. We're hoping to produce an anthology, but we're still looking for a volunteer to put it together.

Corflu is the annual convention for those who enjoy intellectual creativity in the context of Fandom. Started by Fanzine Fans almost 30 years ago, Corflu now embraces audio, video, blogs, listservs, websites and electronic fanzines as well as the traditional variety.

Membership covers the whole three-day convention, including the Sunday Banquet and access to the hospitality suites stocks of food and drink. The three previous Las Vegas Corflus have offered special food events such as a pizza party, deli lunch, the Parade of Cakes and the Midnight Chocolate Feast.

Corflu's program centers on writing, drawing and publishing for Fandom and fanhistory. Vegas Corflu's also have things like nature hikes and pub crawls.
