Membership Address List, Attendee Badges

I intend to continue the Corflu tradition of making available a printed list of all Corflu 33 members, both attending and supporting, with full postal and email address. This will only be available to registered members and not published or made available online.

Cubs Baseball

The Wrigley Chicago Cubs outing is scheduled with 8 lucky fans attending a game vs. The Pittsburgh Pirates on Friday afternoon. Hopefully in the warm sunshine. Tickets have been dispatched to everyone who requested them. If you haven't received these, please let me know asap.

Parking

After reviewing all the various options, there are now two options available: 1. \$26 a day with no in-out privileges in a secure covered garage two blocks from the hotel. 2. \$53 a day in the same garage, but with unlimited in-out privileges. These rates do not include taxes, fees, etc. There is a page on the Corflu website with full details, directions to/from the hotel, and a Google Maps link.

T-shirts

If you ordered shirts, these will be available at the con for pickup. The cost is \$20 for men's shirts, and \$18 for women's. As these shirts have been specially ordered, there will be limited opportunity to purchase if you haven't contacted me off-list to request one. All shirt orders have been confirmed by separate email, or will be shortly.

If you are planning on driving to the con, and require discounted parking please let me know. Currently there are two options, but I haven't given up hope of locating others:

1. Secure Parking Garage, two blocks from hotel. \$26 + taxes each day (typically \$50+ per day). No in-out privileges, but 24 hour access.

2. Surface lot, three blocks from hotel, next door to #1 actually. \$90 for entire weekend, plus taxes. 24 hour access, and in-out privileges. Across from highly-secured Federal Employee parking building.

Go on, prove me wrong. Cast your ballots now. Don't forget. Don't decide it doesn't matter. Don't wait until the very last minute. Think how smug you'd be feeling now if you'd voted before you even saw this PR.

Like many older hotels, there is no hotel parking available, and unless using expensive valet parking is your style, I need to know how many spaces to reserve. Send me your expected arrival and departures times as well.

4. There will be a Fan Fund/Corflu 50/Corflu auction of fannish memorabilia. Many fun and rare items have been promised, but if you also have items to sell/donate, please send a description ahead of time so they can be properly promoted to all interested parties. Remote bidding will be accommodated, but all bidders in the auction will need to be a paid member of Corflu 33, or have donated auction items.

5. There will be t-shirts. Full details in PR2.

Remember, act on all or some of these items today or tomorrow to avoid disappointment later.

Hello,

This is just a quick interim progress report to remind everyone of the upcoming release of the Corflu hotel room block. You need to have a confirmed hotel reservation by April 1st, in order to secure rooms at our preferred rates.

To make a room reservation at the Club Quarters, Central Chicago Loop Hotel location, please use this link:

Note there should be no spaces/line breaks when copying and pasting the link.

At the hotel site you will need to select the dates of the con (May 13-15th) to see the correct rates quoted, these are \$167 and \$182 respectively. Only two room types should be shown. If additional room nights are required, adjust your reservation accordingly, however the hotel doesn't guarantee the Corflu room rate will be available for additional nights.

There is an additional \$18 a night charge for another person to stay in the room. As this is a businessoriented hotel, this charge covers all the complimentary services that the hotel offers (free wi-fi, unrestricted use of business lounge, printers, etc. and a club lounge with complimentary drinks and snacks.)

All rooms are setup with a Queen bed as standard, but if two people are sharing a twin arrangement should be requested at the time of booking and confirmed with the hotel. Some suites are available at a higher rate, these come with an additional sofa bed.

Currently there are 48 members of Corflu 33, including 9 supporters.

PR 2 should be available in a few weeks and will contain other information about Corflu activities, Chicago attractions, travel details and more.
