

MEMBERSHIP EXPLOSION!

The first and best piece of SEACON '79 news, and one we might be forgiven for crowing over, is that to date (1st June, 1978) our membership is in excess of 1,830. This represents massive international support for our convention, especially from North America. We thank you all. Towards the end of this Progress Report you'll find a full and up-to-date alphabetical listing of our members and their status, plus a personal message from our Membership Secretary, Eve Harvey. As Eve points out our membership at the moment exceeds that of both Suncon and Iguanacon at a corresponding stage, and with more than twelve months in hand certainly augurs well for August 1979.

ACCOMMODATION BOOKING

October 1st is the nominal date upon which booking forms for the Metropole and other convention hotels will be posted. It's very important of course that our members return these forms promptly so that we can get as many rooms tied up as possible before the end-of-the-year booking rush for the 1979 holiday season (Brighton is one of Britain's most popular holiday resorts, after all). Bookings for accommodation will be handled by a joint arrangement between Seacon '79 and the official Brighton Accommodation Bureau and no bookings for the convention period will be accepted except through this system. The only exception to this rule concerns suites in the Metropole Hotel itself, of which there is a limited number only. Suites will be allocated separately via Rob Jackson, and as far as possible he will try to ensure these go to individuals (or groups) whose need is greatest — i.e. for professional or entertaining purposes, etc. If you want a suite or indeed, wish to organize any special function (SFWA, SFRA, etc.) during the convention period, write to Rob now, c/o the Seacon '79 address: 14 Henrietta Street, London WC2E 8QJ, U.K.

THE METROPOLE HOTEL & CONFERENCE CENTRE

The Metropole Hotel is one of Brighton's major hotels situated on the sea front and with completely self-contained conference and exhibition facilities. It offers the highest international standard of banqueting in the famous Winter Garden, which is capable of seating 850. The elegant Cameo Room will be used as the main restaurant for the convention period, hopefully offering a buffet menu as fast and reasonably inexpensive fare for a maximum number of guests. The main convention hall has a seating capacity of 2,000 and there is a balcony which is ideal for viewing such events as the Masquerade.

Bars are always a major feature of British conventions, and the Metropole has several spacious ones. Additional bars will be set up as required during the convention. The main convention bar will, needless to say, remain open into the early hours of the morning/night before.

For the health addicts amongst you there is a comprehensive Health Hydro, where you can take advantage of the Sauna and Solarium, enjoy a massage or underwater massage (!) and use the facilities of the gymnasium or the Beauty Salon. (Of course our programme will be so varied and compelling you'll have no time for all this kind of thing!)

PRESS NEWS: SEACON '79: STOP

The hotel has a friendly and accommodating staff who are as eager as we are to see the convention go with a swing. We're sure that those of you for whom this will be the first taste of British hospitality will be agreeably surprised and impressed by the quality of service and comfort offered by the Metropole. That is, after all, the prime reason why we chose it as the site for our Worldcon.

PROGRAMME & PERSONALITIES

At a recent committee meeting the decision was taken to make this a four-day convention; official opening will be on Thursday afternoon, 23rd August, with a full programme of events during the rest of that day (and night).

We hope, in particular, to lay on something special for our official opening, so you are urged to arrive in good time.

Arrangements for the usual sf-orientated talks, lectures and live-events featuring internationally renowned sf personalities are in the pipeline, all in the capable organizing hands of Malcolm Edwards, currently director of the SF Foundation, a British academic body of considerable repute.

Marsha Jones, organizer of Art Shows for most recent British conventions, has agreed to take on the same job for Seacon '79, ensuring a smooth-running display and auction. Susan Lewis, with a vast experience from a myriad U.S. conventions, becomes our North American liaison for the art events.

The Masquerade is always an important feature of any sf convention. We've put the organization in the hands of the adaptable Rob Jackson, and fiancee Coral Clarke. Creators of top award-winning costumes, Carol and Mike Resnick, have agreed to act as North American liaison for this event, which should be spectacular to say the least. We shall also be offering valuable cash prizes, so start planning, if not working on, your costume now.

The film programme for Seacon '79, which should be an extensive continuous-performance affair, is being over-seen by committee member Roy Kettle, with the experienced help of John Brosnan and a host of willing projectionists. There should be a wide range of popular and original films — something for everyone's taste.

The Hucksters and the book auctions also fall under Roy's wing, and Jack Chalker, needing no introduction for his work on North American conventions and as proprietor of Mirage Press, will take a leading role in the auction team and as U.S. liaison for auction materials.

On the social side, rock superstar and blushing committee member Graham Charnock will be organizing something special in the way of a Friday Night Thrash (i.e. dance plus fringe events).

Side by side with our main programme we'll be running a full schedule of fannish events; these will be programmed by Peter Roberts, assisted by the dynamic Pat Charnock. Centred around a large and well-equipped fandom room these events will nevertheless range far and wide. Currently under serious consideration is Robin Johnson's suggestion of an England Vs. Australia fannish cricket test-match. If you fancy yourself as fandom's answer to Len Hutton or Donald Bradman, let us know!

PRESS NEWS: SEACON '79: STOP

Dave Langford, veteran of the 1978 British Skycon, will be co-ordinating the Hugo nomination and voting procedures, while as manager of the business meeting at Seacon we are pleased to have the able assistance of Donald Eastlake, who will also advise us on handling the 1981 site selection ballot.

Further appointments to the growing rank of willing Seacon slaves include Martin Hoare, reputed to have most of British fandom now on computer, who joins us as Seacon's data processing manager, and Tim Stannard, a qualified solicitor and partner in a Birmingham practice, who joins Seacon as legal adviser.

You'll gather, we hope, from the above that Seacon '79 is much larger than its Steering Committee; it's a large and continually growing body representative of British and International fandom all working together to hopefully make Seacon a very special Worldcon.

SEE YOU AT IGUANACON

The intrepid Malcolm Edwards will be braving jet-lag and the ravages of an expense-account to represent Seacon at IGUANACON, together with one or two of our U.S. agents. Feel free to raise any queries or problems with Malcolm, or merely exchange gossip. We'll be de-briefing him thoroughly when he returns to the fold.

PART ONE

ON SUNDAY, JANUARY 3rd, 1937, some twenty sf fans assembled in the Theosophical Hall, Leeds, for the very first organized science fiction convention anywhere. The idea has obviously spread since then and in Britain alone dozens of sf conventions have been held in the last forty or so years. In the next few Progress Reports we're intending to take a look at these British conventions, partly out of simple historical interest and partly to provide some background to British fandom and Seacon '79.

The three pre-war conventions appear to have been pretty solemn affairs. SF fandom itself had only come into being a few years earlier and the first local sf groups weren't formed till 1936, the same year as the publication of the first British fanzine, Novae Terrae. SF itself barely existed outside the pulps and science fiction was no more than a strange minority interest, ignored by most authors and publishers and with no guaranteed future. Pre-war fandom was thus anxious to establish itself and was enthusiastic over anything remotely connected with sf and the future; it would have been surprising, therefore, if these first conventions had been anything other than formal.

The 1937 convention was organized by the Leeds Chapter of the Science Fiction League, an international association sponsored by Hugo Gernsback and Wonder Stories (other chapters over here were in Nuneaton, Glasgow, Belfast, and Barnsley!). Most of the attendees were local; but six prominent fans made the journey from other parts of Britain: Ted (John) Carnell, Arthur C. Clarke, and Walter Gillings from London; Leslie Johnson and Eric Frank Russell from Liverpool; and Maurice Hanson from Nuneaton. The convention opened at 10.30am and messages were read from Professor A.M. Low, Dr Olaf Stapledon, H.G. Wells, John Russell Fearn, Festus Pragnell, and the Oklahoma Scientific Association. Visiting fans then gave talks: Walter Gillings on the possibilities of a British sf magazine ("Fans must not expect a British Astounding Stories. SF has been so neglected that England will have to start at the beginning with simple themes."); Ted Carnell on international fandom and fanzines (the latter "springing up like mushrooms", no less than 25 being produced around the world); Arthur C. Clarke (described only as an "ex-Taunton fan") talked on the British Interplanetary Society; and Maurice Hanson "told a sad story of inactivity in Nuneaton". After a break for lunch the convention met to create a new organization, the Science Fiction Association, "whose objects would be to encourage publishers to pay more attention to scientific fiction and to stimulate public interest in scientific

ideas." There was some squabbling over who should be President, with H.G. Wells supporters arguing against champions of Aldous Huxley, and others (no decision was reached). To round off the day, Leslie Johnson "outlined the present state of rocketry abroad" and Eric Frank Russell "declared that scientifiction was the simplest of all mediums to write."

The first convention must have been a success, because another was organized the following year, this time by the newly formed SFA. On April 10th, 1938, forty fans turned up at the Ancient Order Of Druids Memorial Institute in London; the programme opened at 4.00pm with the AGM of the SFA, including official reports from around the country and the election of a new President (Prof. A.M. Low). After an interval the evening session began with messages of greetings to the con, followed by speeches from Leslie Johnson, Benson Herbert, Professor Low, I.O. Evans, John Russell Fearn, Walter Gillings, and Douglas Mayer. The convention then retired for supper. It all sounds depressingly dull, but William F. Temple's account of the alcoholic aftermath (in the company of fans such as Ted Carnell, Arthur C. Clarke, and John (Wyndham) Harris) suggests that the event was not entirely solemn and sober. Temple's SFA supper ended up over the platform at London Bridge station and conventions were already becoming more interesting.

The fans returned to the Druids Hall for the 1939 convention held on May 21st. Attendance was again around forty, "including several ladies". The SFA AGM was held in the afternoon and was apparently enlivened by Arthur C. Clarke's "general knowledge questionnaire", in which a team of provincial fans beat a team of Londoners. There were three main speeches in the evening by Professor Low, Walter Gillings, and W.J. Passingham ("author of several sf serials") and once again there was a supper. Fans present included David McIlwain ("Charles Eric Maine"), John Burke, Ron Holmes, Bill Temple, Eric Needham, and Sam Youd ("John Christopher"). Ted Carnell summed up the impact of the day's convention: "Physical reaction-throat like a rasp, voice like a bag of rusty nails, kaleidoscopic eyesight, pumpkin head, and a backache like none of your business. Mental reaction - it was a swell turnout."

. And then the war came. British fandom was dispersed, travel was limited, paper was rationed, and conventions became a luxury of the past. Thanks largely to Michael Rosenblum and his Futurian War Digest, however, contacts were kept up: there were a couple of fan gatherings, in London and at Harry Turner's home in Manchester, in 1941. But it wasn't until 1943 that a real sf convention was staged again in Britain.

Unfortunately the 1943 Midvention seemed to be less than a success. Held over Easter weekend (April 23rd-26th), it was switched at the last minute from Birmingham to a hall in Leicester, and attracted no more than fourteen fans. The planned programme disintegrated as a result and the auction (at which some big-spender paid 5/2d for a portfolio of Finlay illustrations) was considered to be "the high spot of the convention". Other items included listening to records of Caruso singing Wagner; a fruitless debate on sf and fantasy; listening to Ron Holmes playing the piano; a "Brains Trust" discussion; and watching a display of fencing. Since no food was available anywhere in Leicester over Easter weekend, attendees were obliged to visit a local fan's house for meals. No professional writers turned up.

The Midvention, however, must have inspired fans, because the following year no less than four conventions were held in Britain. The first took place in Manchester over the New Year (1943/4) weekend; attendance at this Norcon was "somewhat more meagre than anticipated" - something of an understatement, since a grand total of eight fans turned up. They seemed to enjoy themselves, however, and were all comfortably accommodated in Ron Lane's house. Main events included a visit to the zoo and the intermittent production of a convention booklet.

The 1944 Eastercon, organized by the Teddington Cosmos Club, was the largest convention of the year (and indeed of the war). Some two dozen fans showed up for a perambulation around London on the Saturday and for the convention proper (mainly consisting of films, auctions, and fruitless attempts to read an utterly illegible programme book) in Shirley's Cafe, Teddington, on the Sunday. Walter Gillings was the con's President and attendees included Seacon '79's Canadian Agent, John Millard (proving just how long your present committee has been planning the Worldcon).

Believe it or not, the Second Midvention, held in Leicester over the weekend of September 2nd/3rd, was even less successful than the previous year's fiasco. The six fans that turned up enjoyed themselves, however, at their usual pursuits of listening to music and watching displays of fencing.

The final convention of the year was the Second Norcon which attracted some fourteen fans to Leeds on the weekend of December 29th/30th. The con was mostly held at the home of Mike Rosenblum and appears to have been a thoroughly informal affair, the main items being an exploration of Leeds (including a "visit to the world's largest block of flats") and a viewing of Hoppity Goes to Town. Attendees included Ron Holmes, Ron Lane, Ron Bradbury, and Los Angeles fan, Gus Willmorth.

The problems caused by wartime restrictions obviously destroyed the formal arrangements of the pre-war conventions; with only a small number of fans attending (most of them knowing each other through letters and the personalzines distributed with Futurian War Digest) the conventions became social events rather than sober conferences on sf. How far this influenced later conventions is, however, open to question, since British fandom reached a low ebb in the early post-war years and there was once again a break in conventions.

The earliest post-war convention, the 1948 Whitcon, is paradoxically considered the first in the current series of British national Eastercons. Organized by John Newman, it was held in London on Whit Sunday, May 15th. Some fifty people turned up at the famous fan pub, The White Horse, for an assortment of speeches and auctions.

And that's about it for British conventions up to 1950. There was an Easter Loncon in 1949, but despite diligent searching amongst the cobwebs I've failed to find any report of the convention. This underlines the fact that I've relied on accounts printed in contemporary fanzines for this article and it's quite probable, therefore, that a lot of notable material has been left out. In the next Progress Report I'll be talking about the comparatively recent history of British conventions since 1950. Meanwhile I'd be delighted to hear from the attendees of any of these early British conventions who can provide information, memories, and anecdotes about them. 
