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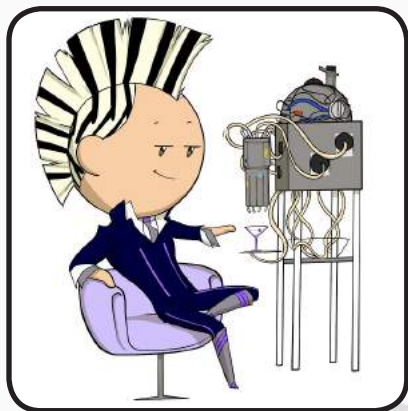

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From the Chair



OK, here we go—the first Official Progress Report from Worldcon 76 in San Jose!

The World Science Fiction Convention is, to me, the World's Fair of fandom. No other event brings together fans and creators, regardless of genre or medium, under one “big tent” with the face-to-face intimacy of Worldcon. There are lots of big pop culture conventions (quite a few bigger than Worldcon), but none of them feature the “everybody creates this event together” culture that makes Worldcon such a unique international gathering.

Just last month at Worldcon 75 in Helsinki, Finland, I had the privilege of announcing our final two Guests of Honor, artist John Picacio and musician Frank Hayes, who join GoHs Spider Robinson, Chelsea Quinn Yarbro, Pierre and Sandy Pettinger, and our posthumous Ghost and gHost of Honor Edgar Pangborn and Bob Wilkins. We look forward to sharing their talents in person with you next August, and I'm sure they are working on cunning plans with my Program and Exhibits divisions already.

Peruse this report to get a taste and feeling for what we're preparing for you... Inside, you'll find initial info about our location, our hotels, our events, our exhibits, our program plans and our take on Worldcon culture. Our theme is “Make The Future,” but our motto is *Spectacular, Spectacular!* Everyone on the committee is working to think outside of the box on ways to make Worldcon 76 a truly unique, enjoyable, and memorable experience for all members, fan and pro alike.

When I put forward my name for consideration to chair, I knew it would be a tremendous amount of work. That is certainly true – and few weeks go by where I am not surprised by some detail under the covers of convention management that would not be apparent to even a long-time attendee of Worldcon – but

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more importantly, I see the incredibly talented and dedicated people who've joined the team working to plan, design, and deal with the challenges of such a diverse event. It typically takes about 10% of the membership of a Worldcon to actually run it—I hope you'll consider adding your talents to the mix in some fashion!

“Make the Future” is a deliberate reference to the booming worldwide “maker culture,” which has strong roots in the San Francisco Bay Area. And it celebrates our deeper philosophical belief that it is by the choices we make together that we steer not only the fan community, but humanity in general, towards the brighter future we aspire to build. Please join with us to make that future!

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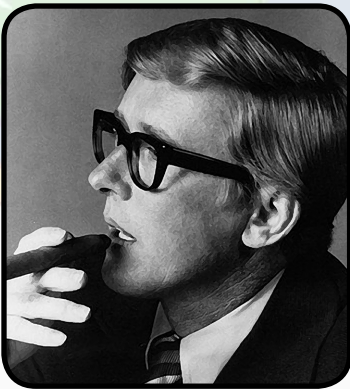
Guests of Honor

Pierre and Sandy Pettinger • Fans

Attending conventions since 1981, and active in costuming since 1983, Pierre and Sandy Pettinger won their first costuming award at the World Science Fiction Convention in 1986. Their expertise and love of the form drove them to win more awards than can be listed here, but notably includes 4 Worldcon Best in Show awards. They are also active in costume judging, and masquerade management, as well as serving in executive positions in the St. Louis Costumers Guild (a.k.a. The St. Louis Ubiquitous Tailoring Society, or SLUTS), a chapter of the International Costumers' Guild. (True Fact: They were committee members for San Jose's last worldcon, ConJosé in 2002, and ran our masquerade there.)



Bob Wilkins • gHost of Honor



"Watch Horror Films, Keep America Strong!" was Bob Wilkin's slogan as TV host of several decades of horror and science fiction films programs in Northern California. From Sacramento to the Bay Area, Bob's dry wit and cheap cigars punctuated the commercial breaks in front of some of the flimsiest sets and craziest props on TV. Whether he was acting out an episodic skit, or hosting as who's who of fantastic actors, Wilkins was the lynchpin of local television movie night tradition.

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Chelsea Quinn Yarbro • Author



Two life-changing things happened to Chelsea Quinn Yarbro in 1968: she attended her first WorldCon and she sold her first story. Since then, she has attended many more conventions and published 81 works of short fiction in multiple genres and is presently working on her 95th sold book.

As well as science fiction, Yarbro writes mysteries, horror, non-fiction, westerns, young adult, and fantasy, most under her own name, but some under pseudonyms. By the time the 2018 WorldCon rolls around, she plans to be at work on her 100th sold book.

Spider Robinson • Author

In writing, Spider Robinson found a way to escape from his job guarding a New York sewer. Almost immediately he created one of the best known and loved places in Science Fiction and Fantasy; Callahan's Place. Writing with humor, a singular imagination, and a grounded sense of what people are really all about, his rise to fame was immediate and accelerated. His reputation today is supported by dozens of books, several series, an impressive array of short stories and a wealth of essays and reviews. Married for over 30 years to dancer, teacher and occasional co-writer, the late Jeanne Robinson, Spider Robinson provides us with stories displaying signature thoughtfulness, wit, irreverence, and unique insights into the human condition.



Edgar Pangborn • Ghost of Honor



An American writer of mystery, historical, and science fiction, Edgar Pangborn was the son of a supernatural fiction writer and a dictionary editor. Leaving his Harvard musical studies incomplete, he shifted to a career in fiction. Initially he wrote pulp detective and mystery stories under a pseudonym as he developed his craft, then shifted in the 1950's to science fiction and mystery writing in a humanist style that would inspire the next generation of writers such as Peter S. Beagle and Ursula K. Le Guin. More than 25 years after his death, Pangborn's sister left his papers and literary

works, including many not previously published, to Beagle who worked to bring the best of them into print.

Frank Hayes • Music

Armed with a guitar and an ironic, wry sense of humor, Frank Hayes has been filking at science fiction conventions since 1979. Some of his best known pieces are "Never Set the Cat on Fire", "Little Fuzzy Animals", and "Like a Lamb to the Slaughter", a talking blues version of the traditional folk song Mattie Groves.

He has been nominated sixteen times for the Pegasus Award for Excellence in Filking and has won five: Best Parody, Best Risqué Song, Best Filk Song, Best Classic Filk Song, and Best Alien Song.

His song Cosmos was used to wake up the astronauts on the Space Shuttle. Mercedes Lackey said of him, "funny enough to make people fall down on the ground and gasp for breath at first hearing."



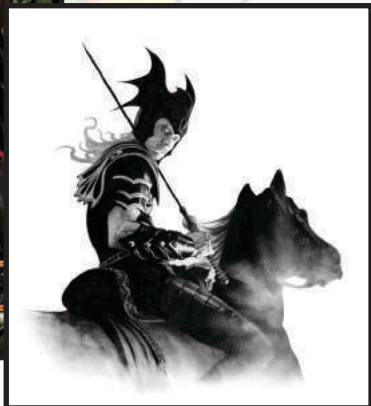
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John Picacio • Artist

Equally at home with a pencil, a paintbrush, or sitting in front of a computer, John Picacio's artwork often combines traditional mediums, such as drawing or painting, with digital flourishes. He is noted for the diversity and range of his artistic endeavors.

His art has illustrated the covers of books by Robert Silverberg, L.E. Modesitt, Jr., Michael Moorcock, and Frederik Pohl to name just a few. His art has adorned magazines including Asimov's *Science Fiction* and *Interzone*. He illustrated the 2012 George RR Martin: *A Song of Ice and Fire* calendar. His art has graced the covers for works in both the Star Trek™ and the X-Men universes.

He is the recipient of two Hugo Awards, a World Fantasy Award, two Locus Awards, eight Chesley Awards and two International Horror Guild Awards.



Membership

WSFS: You're a Member

If you're a member of Worldcon 76 San Jose, you're a member of WSFS: the World Science Fiction Society. The WSFS division manages the official business of the Society, the three very important areas that make the convention a Worldcon. WSFS includes the Hugo Awards Administration, which conducts the Hugo Award voting; Site Selection, which manages the elections to choose the site of the future Worldcons and (if required) the North American Science Fiction Conventions (NASFiCs); and the WSFS Business Meeting, where changes to the WSFS rules, including the Hugo Awards and Site Selection, are debated and voted upon.

All attending and supporting members of Worldcon 76 are eligible to nominate and vote on the final ballot for the Hugo Awards, to vote on future Worldcon (and if required, NASFiC) site selection, and to participate in the Business Meeting. You must be an attending member to actually attend and vote at the Business Meeting; however, supporting members may submit business. Worldcon is not just a convention; it's a society, and you're a member of it.

Hotels

Figuring out where you're going to stay is important whether you come for the week or the weekend. There are numerous hotels to choose from near the Convention Center, and we have room block arrangements with many of them! NOTE: Room reservations open in Fall 2017. Check our website for details.

San Jose Marriott • 301 S Market St.

\$139/night • single/double/triple/quad

SJ in 2018's headquarters hotel will not be familiar to 2002 Worldcon attendees, as it opened in 2003. The San Jose Marriott is the newest hotel connected to McEnery Convention Center. Since opening, it's been the headquarters hotel for Further Confusion (2012-present) and hosted the 2014 SFWA Nebula Awards Weekend. Spacious rooms with beautiful views of the hills surrounding San Jose are the norm at the Marriott. While there are plenty of other places downtown to eat and drink, the Marriott's TANQ bar and Arcadia Steakhouse are both fabulous.

The Marriott has a total of 478 rooms including 10 suites, 248 king rooms, and 201 double rooms. Accessibility is excellent.

Our main block has rooms from August 14 (Tuesday) through August 20 (Monday), with peak room commitment of 340 rooms for Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Some additional shoulder nights are available. Note that suite reservations will be administered by Worldcon 76.

Hilton San Jose • 300 S Almaden Blvd

\$149/night • single/double

At the west end of the convention center, the Hilton San Jose is conveniently located for convention events and nightlife. The Hilton San Jose hosted the 2013 SFWA Nebula Awards Weekend, and is also a host hotel for Further Confusion. Triple rooms will \$169 and Quad \$189.

Hotels

The Hilton San Jose has 353 rooms, including 17 suites, 117 king rooms and 294 double queen rooms. All king rooms are ADA compliant, and the hotel does have rooms with additional accommodations for hearing and mobility needs, including roll-in showers. Our main block has rooms from August 14 (Tuesday) through August 20 (Monday), with peak room commitment of 247 rooms for Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Some additional shoulder nights are available. Note that suite reservations will be administered by Worldcon 76.

Fairmont Hotel • 170 S Market St starting at \$199

The Party hotel will be the Fairmont, about 800m from the Marriott and the convention center entrance. It has enough suites and larger rooms to support the usual Worldcon evening social life. Our main block has rooms from August 14 (Tuesday) through August 20 (Monday). Our peak room commitment at the Fairmont is 450 rooms for Friday, Saturday, and Sunday (this does not include suites). Some additional shoulder nights are available.

Standard rooms are \$199 Single-Double/\$224 Triple/\$249 Quad Occupancy. Deluxe (larger) rooms are \$239 Single-Double/\$264 Triple/\$289 Quad occupancy. Fairmont one-bedroom suites (bedroom plus a standard parlor) are \$339. Note that suite reservations for parties will be administered by Worldcon 76.

Hyatt Place San Jose • 282 S Almaden Blvd starting at \$189

The Hyatt Place San Jose is directly across the street (north) from the Convention Center. It features a free breakfast buffet. Rooms are \$189 Single-Double, \$209 Triple, or \$229 Quad occupancy. Our main block has rooms from August 14 (Tuesday) through August 20 (Monday), with peak room commitment of 150 rooms for Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. Some additional shoulder nights are available.

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Hotels

(Westin) Sainte Claire Hotel • 302 S Market starting at \$179

Currently a Westin, but still sporting the historic Sainte Claire blade sign, this historic property is directly across the street (east) from the Marriott end of the Convention Center. Rooms are \$179 Single-Double, \$189 Triple, or \$199 Quad occupancy. Note that most rooms are single/double occupancy. Our block has rooms from August 15 (Wednesday) through August 20 (Monday). We have a peak room commitment of 90 rooms for Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.

AC Hotel by Marriott • 350 W Santa Clara starting at \$179

The AC Hotel is about 5 blocks (just over a kilometer) away from the Convention Center. Rooms are \$179 Single-Double, \$199 Triple, or \$219 Quad occupancy. Our block has rooms from August 15 (Wednesday) through August 20 (Monday). We have a peak room commitment of 100 rooms for Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.



San Jose Culture

Fan Culture

San Jose is a geeky, geeky town. Established high-tech companies like Adobe and tiny little start-ups make downtown San Jose their home. Flying into Mineta San Jose International Airport, you'll see many more tech company headquarters and facilities. What you won't see from your window, though, is San Jose's fun geeky side.

San Jose has a great convention scene. Whether it's Further Confusion, Silicon Valley Comic Con, FanimeCon, or Clockwork Alchemy, there are events for every sort of fan in San Jose. There is also BayCon in San Mateo, Con-Volution in San Ramon, FogCon in Walnut Creek, a calendar of great gaming conventions throughout northern California and a really great annual Lego conference.

San Jose's SF club scene is also thriving. BASFA engages in genre discussions over dinner with a side-order of recreational parliamentary procedure every Monday. PenSFA is a lot less structured, but very, very social. The Legion of Rassilon has monthly meetings, focusing on Doctor Who and British genre television. And then there are all the ad-hoc weekly fan gatherings.

Food & Drink

Downtown San Jose is very proud of its restaurant scene, featuring a wide range of prices and cuisines. Our downtown restaurants cater to high-tech office tower workers, San José State University students, and everyone in between. Our taquerias are diverse and very authentic, but Mexican cuisine here isn't limited to taquerias. Vietnamese options abound and not just pho and bánh mì. Japanese of every sort is available, both within walking distance and a few light rail stops away in San Jose's Japantown. The Britannia Arms provides traditional English pub fare. I could go on, but I don't need to.

Maker Culture

The Bay Area's art scene, geeky culture and high-tech expertise was a natural cradle for the "maker" subculture that has grown up over the last few years. Burning Man, RoboGames, Maker Faire, the TechShop, all have driven enthusiasm in creative arts and crafts.

San Jose Culture

Arts & Entertainment

San Jose is a great town for the arts, and downtown San Jose is a growing arts area. South FIRST FRIDAYS is a monthly downtown art walk showcasing local galleries and venues only blocks away from the San Jose Convention Center. SLG Publishing created Art Boutiki, a comic shop that is so much more than just a comic shop.

We're very solid in the museum department. The Tech Museum of Innovation, Children's Discovery Museum of San Jose and the San Jose Museum of Art are all right downtown. We've also got the Rosicrucian Egyptian Museum and Gardens, a quirky little place with a seriously amazing collection of ancient Egyptian artifacts. Of course, if "quirky" is your thing, Sarah Winchester's Winchester Mystery House holds the record on taking "quirky" over the top. And there are plenty of other museums (Computer History Museum, anyone?) nearby.

If live music and live theater is your scene, we've got you covered. Live music is common at many of our downtown bars, clubs and cafes. We've got some amazing independent theater companies, and quirky little theaters that they call home.



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In the Exhibit Hall

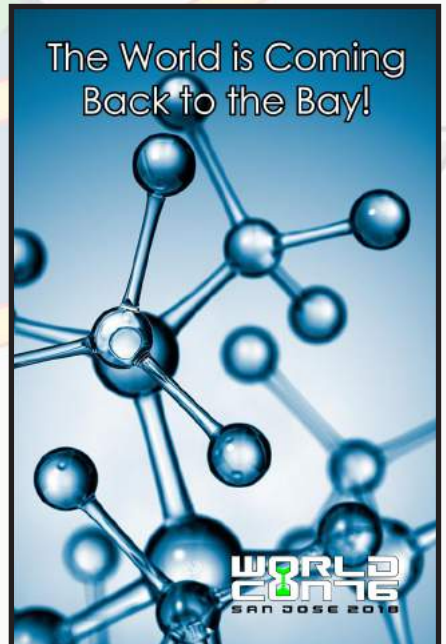

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Programming

The Programming Division is already hard at work generating ideas and contacting people to participate, but it's not just about panels—it's also about Gaming and Klatsches and Workshops and Music—with the occasional Lecture on topics both hard and soft, or demonstrations of wild, weird and wonderful skills and techniques.

If you're an aspiring writer, consider participating in the Writers Workshop. This is an opportunity to have both new and experienced authors critique your work. Many well known writers got their feet wet at a Worldcon Writers' Workshop. Not sure you're ready for that? Consider participating in a Deep Dive, where discussion focuses around how to write a particular type of scene or develop a character. Workshops aren't limited to just writers and artists. Whether you want to learn to make a prop or prosthetic, dance a new step, sing a new song, or learn almost anything, it's likely to be something we will offer.

Want an opportunity to meet an author or artist? Consider signing up for a Kaffeeklatsch or Literary Beer. This is an opportunity for 8-10 people to hang out with someone in a casual environment, or go for a Stroll With The Stars some morning.

Sign ups for both Klatsches and Workshops will only be done on-site (with more details to come).

Music is a big part of our programming. We are planning events both big and small, and will be going into the wee hours every night. Bring your voices and instruments to join in a filk circle, or just have a seat and listen to the wide variety of music that happens at Worldcon.

Do you have an interest or belong to a fandom and want to meet people who share that interest? A Birds of a Feather (BoF) session might be just the thing! We'll have some space set aside for impromptu BoFs, but you can suggest one in advance to get it scheduled, too!

Many of the best attractions — the national monuments and memorials, the Smithsonian Institution museums, and even the National Zoo — are free to the public, and are well-served by the WMATA Metro rail and bus system, Circulator buses, cabs, and Capital Bikeshare service.

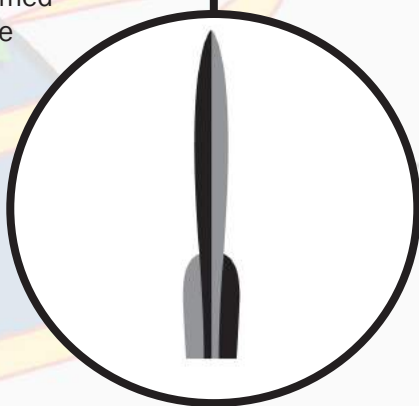

Awards Ceremony

At Worldcon 75 in Helsinki, the Guinness Book of World Records recognized the Hugo Awards as the longest running science fiction award. Worldcon 76 will host the 65th Hugo Awards Ceremony, with SFWA Grandmaster Robert Silverberg expected to continue his own record of having attended every Hugo Ceremony.

Worldcon 75's WSFS Business Meeting ratified the addition of two new Worldcon administered awards, a Hugo for Best Series, and an as yet unnamed non-Hugo award for Young Adult speculative fiction. San Jose will thus award 17 Hugos and the two non-Hugo awards administered by Worldcon, the Young Adult award and the John W. Campbell Award for Best New Writer. All these awards are nominated and voted on by all Worldcon members. Nominations will open early in 2018. If you think something you've read or seen in this year's current crop of works is award worthy, nominate it. Then, later in the year, vote!

With the Convention Center's renovation, the Ceremony will be held Sunday night in its new ballroom area, rather than across the street as in 2002. Plan to join us there to see which creators and which works join the ranks of Hugo winners (and then have the happy problem of getting a two-foot-tall metal rocketship through airport security).

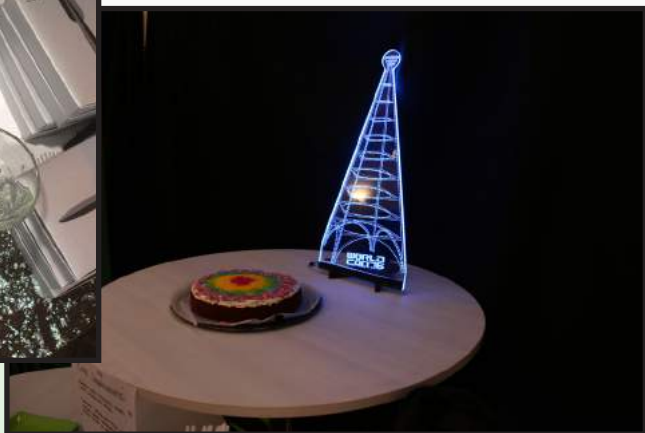

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Site Selection: Call for Bids

In Helsinki, Dublin 2019 was selected to host the 2019 Worldcon. Because the 2019 Worldcon will be outside North America, Worldcon 76 will be holding not just a 2020 Worldcon site selection, but also a 2019 NASFiC site selection. The filing deadline for both ballots will be February, 17, 2018; however, all bids filed after that date but before the close of site selection will still be eligible as write-in candidates.

Notice to 2020 Worldcon and 2019 NASFiC Bidders

Per section 4.6 of the WSFS Constitution, candidates must file a statement of their intent to bid and provide adequate evidence of an agreement with their proposed site's facilities and the rules under which their Worldcon Committee will operate (particularly including the procedures for the selection, term of

office, and replacement of their chief executive officer or officers). Sites more than 500 miles from the San Jose McEnergy Convention Center will be eligible for either site selection, though only a North American site may participate in NASFiC site selection. Interested parties may direct questions regarding either site selection to **site-selection@worldcon76.org**. Once we receive bid filings in either race, they will be made available on our site selection page on our website.
