

The Hugo and Campbell Award Winners

Bucconeer, the 56th World Science Fiction Convention, has presented the 1998 Hugo Awards and John W. Campbell Award at a ceremony in Baltimore, Maryland on Friday, August 7th.

Bucconeer received 769 valid ballots for the awards. They were counted and verified by the Hugo Administrators, John Lorentz and Ruth Sachter, with the assistance of software developed by Jeffrey L. Copeland.
