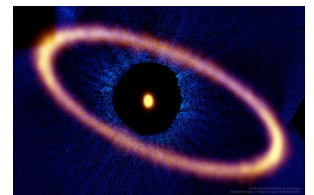

Tade Thompson is the author of the Arthur C. Clarke Award-winning novel *Rosewater*. He previously won the Kitschies Golden Tentacle Award with *Making Wolf*. He has been a finalist for the John W. Campbell Award and has been nominated for the Shirley Jackson and BFA Awards. Born in London to Yoruba parents, he lives and works on the south coast of England where he battles an addiction to books.



Alison Scott, Guest of Honour

Alison Scott has been attending conventions since 1984 and running them since 1986. She's also a fan writer, editor and artist. As a member of the Plokta cabal she won the Best Fanzine Hugo twice, as well as numerous awards for fan art and other work. She chaired two Eastercons and helped run the Fan Room at the 2005 Glasgow Worldcon and the Fan Village at Loncon 3, the 2014 London Worldcon.

Concentric 2020 Hotel and Venue

The Hilton Birmingham Metropole

Concentric 2020 will be held at the Hilton Birmingham Metropole, which is located in the hotel and leisure park area behind the National Exhibition Centre (NEC). Previously used for the 2017 Eastercon, Innominate, the Metropole has 33 function rooms and 4,273 square meters of versatile meeting space for all the expected Eastercon programme and activities.

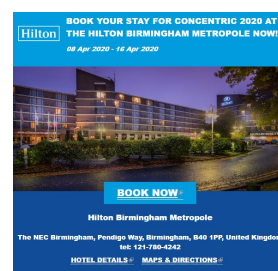
Hotel Facilities (partial list)

Accommodation

Getting to Concentric 2020

The NEC has its own railway station (Birmingham International), served by four train lines with connections to all over Britain and connected by a 90-second rail link to Birmingham International Airport. More than 120 daily National Express and Megabus coaches and Network West Midlands buses stop at the station.

The rail station and airport are within walking distance and are served by a 24-hour complimentary shuttle bus service from the hotel.

- You could offer to spend an hour sharing coffee round a table with a dozen people who want to talk to you about your work.
- You could offer to run some sort of game, or crafting activity, or learning experience, or workshop or ... well, we don't know yet. We'll find out if you fill in that form, or the survey that'll follow.

So we'd like you, please, to register your interest in appearing on the programme, by going to the website at <https://www.concentric2020.uk/> and looking under the 'What's On' menu for the Programme Participants form. You can use that form to supply us with your email address, and that will enable us to send you a more comprehensive survey (or more) in the coming months.

We'll have a number of people in our programming team, each helping to assemble streams of programming on a particular topic – science items, literary criticism, politics and society, crafts and makers, comic books, filk, children's programme, fan history, and plain old tomfoolery.

If you have a great idea for a programme item, and don't want to appear in it yourself, just want us to pick it up and run with it, there's another link under that "What's On" menu, which will take you to the Programme Suggestions form. Please find it, and use it. We'll be grateful, I promise. Or you could just email ConProgIdeas@gmail.com and we'll be grateful for that too.

The programme's going to be brilliant, we're sure. But we're only sure of that because we're confident that many of you are going to come up with brilliant material, including your very own selves. Please go and fill in those forms. Thank you.
