Welcome to the programme grid. That is all there is in this publication a grid of where and when every item known about when the grid went to press, is and a map to help find your way there.

Useful notes.

1. The grid does not have equal spaces for time, each row has a starting time and all items at that time are shown on that row.
2. Most items are an hour. Book signings are 45 minutes. Some things are much longer. Those are shown with a grey bar extending down with the number of minutes at the top. The length very roughly indicates the time. Use the numbers.
3. Each double page spread covers the full spread at any time.
4. Rooms not used in the time shown are omitted
5. Tours, Kaffeeklatsches, literary beers and some workshops need sign-up due to limited numbers. See programme book.
6. The map is on the central pages.

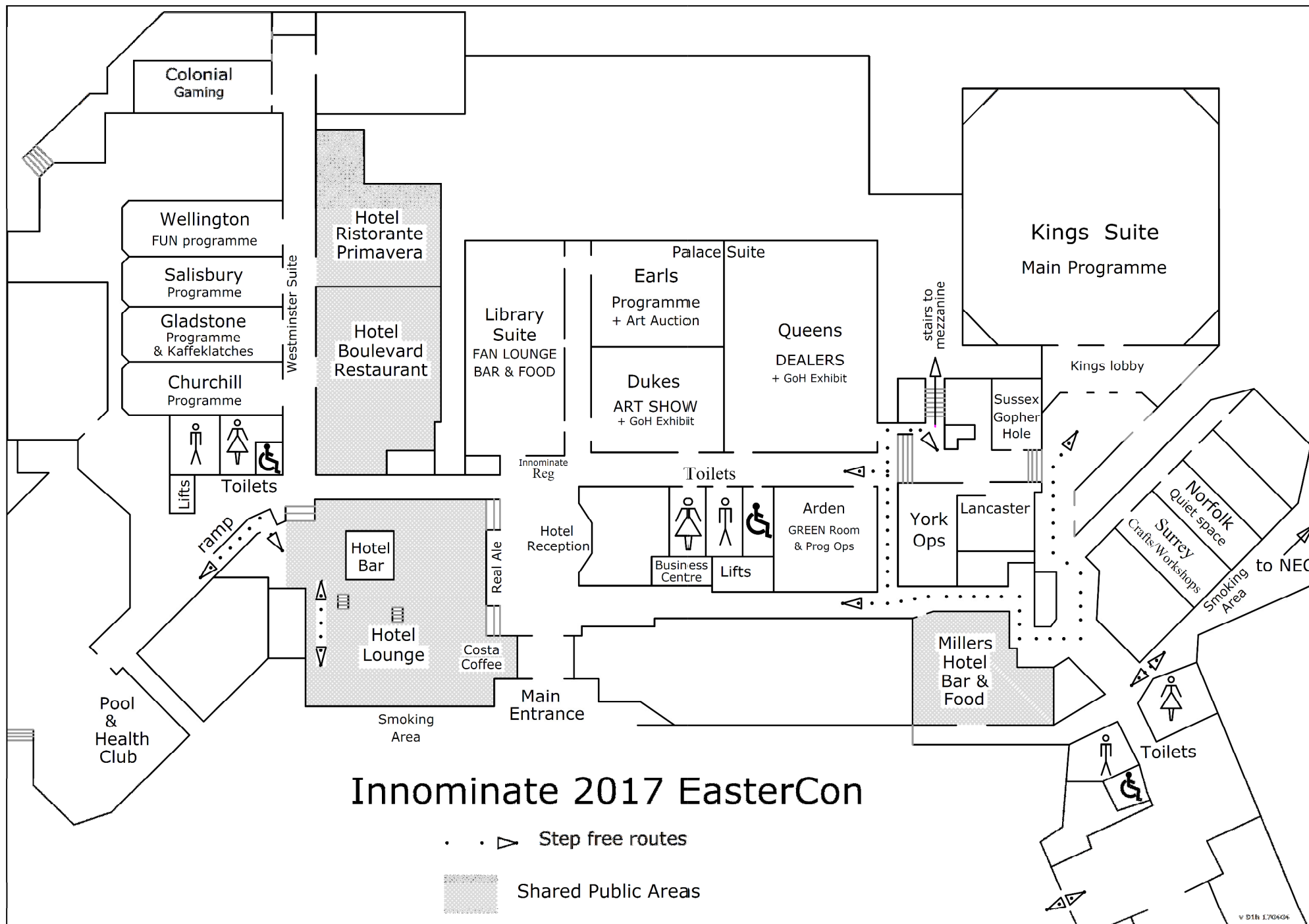
