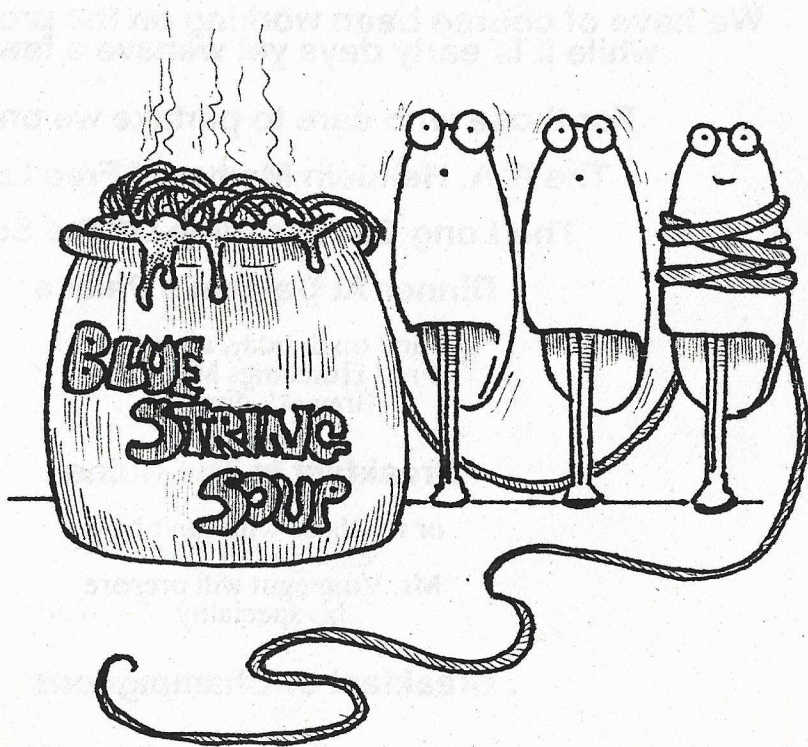

Soupçon

Soupçon is designed to be a convention of about 150-200 people to be held at the Hotel de France on Jersey in the autumn of 1991. We will run a small, lightly-programmed convention where people can relax and enjoy all aspects of the con, the hotel and Jersey.

We will run a single-stream programme in the afternoons and evenings, leaving the mornings free for sight-seeing and, of course, duty-free shopping. The programme will be entertaining whilst also being informing and, we hope, provoking.

The main event. The one item we have always planned for this particular con is the Saturday evening banquet. The banquet at Contrivance was a major success, and so we are planning to try again with a larger budget and a wider brief for the chef. Don't miss it, especially if you're vegetarian.

This will be followed by an after-dinner speech, given by our Guest of Honour. We do not yet have a confirmed Guest, but we can promise that whoever we invite will add to your enjoyment of the convention.

Soupçon will be held over the week-end of 25 to 27 October, 1991.

We are very happy to announce that our Guest of Honour is IAN WATSON.

The Hotel de France, which hosted the Eastercon this year, was extremely well-received by the membership, and we had no hesitation in picking it for Soupçon. We expect to negotiate a room rate of about £30 per person per night for single and twin rooms. This includes breakfast but not VAT, since Jersey doesn't have VAT.

There is only one rate - full membership, which is set at £15.

We will not organise a discount travel scheme as was done for Contrivance. The small numbers involved mean that better deals can be obtained by booking in advance at travel agents. Similarly, we will not be organising a book room or art show due to the costs involved.
