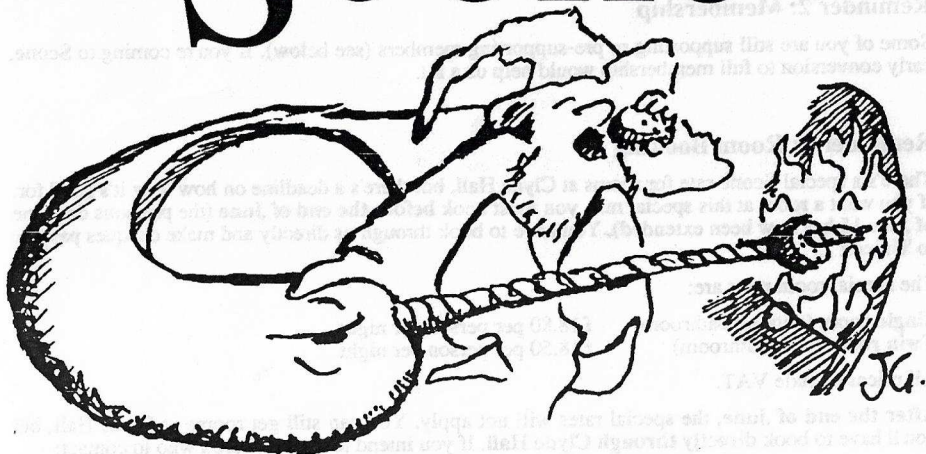


Scone

Other notes:

Reminder 1: When And Where

Scone will be held at Clyde Hall, a hall of residence attached to Strathclyde University, in Glasgow on the weekend of the 7th to the 9th of August, 1992.

Reminder 2: Membership

Some of you are still supporting or pre-supporting members (see below). If you're coming to Scone, early conversion to full membership would help us a lot.

Reminder 3: Room Booking

There's a special Scone rate for rooms at Clyde Hall, but there's a deadline on how long it's good for. If you want a room at this special rate, you must book **before the end of June** (the previous deadline of June 15 has now been extended). You have to book through us directly and make cheques payable to 'Unicon 13'.

The special room rates are:

Single room (without bathroom)	£18.80 per person per night
Twin room (with bathroom)	£18.50 per person per night

All prices include VAT.

After the end of June, the special rates will not apply. You can still get rooms at Clyde Hall, but you'll have to book **directly through Clyde Hall**. If you intend to do this, here's who to contact:
