He was associated with Harlan Ellison and collaborated with him on the novel *Phoenix Without Ashes*—based upon Harlan's script for an episode of *The Starlost*. He won two Nebula Awards for short stories. He was a contributor to the *Wild Cards* series of novels and short fiction.

Robert A. Rosenberg (1947--8 October 2016). Although he died four months ago, fandom did not find out about this until very recently. He was a member of the Lunarians and the Lunarians₂ and a Director-at-Large of the organization.
