Meet Shelby Vick

The tall, slender and invariably smiling Shelby Vick has been an active fan for over 60 years. In the early 1950's, Shelby was part of the "big four" – the others were Lee Hoffman, Walt Willis and Max Keasler – that did so much to define our hobby. They introduced a brand of sophisticated, witty fannishness that has largely set the tone for our subculture.

Shelby Vick has contributed to Fandom as a writer, cartoonist and fanzine publisher. *Confusion* was one of the most popular and entertaining fanzines of the early 1950's and he's still an active faned in 2011 with *Planetary Stories*. His amusing columns and charming Puffin cartoons have graced many fanzines over the years.

If Shelby Vick isn't the nicest person in Fandom, I have yet to meet the man or woman who out-does him in that regard. He is so unfailingly modest, kind and generous that it almost unbelievable. Then, if you're fortunate enough to get to know him, you quickly discover that Shelby is exactly the honorable, caring person he appears to be.

It's fitting that Shelby Vick will represent the Corflu Fifty at Corflu Glitter, because he sparked the creation of today's fan funds with his "WAW with the Crew in '52" campaign that brought Walt Willis to the 1952 worldcon in Chicago.

The Corflu Fifty, founded four years ago, sends a worthy fan to Corflu each year. Its members pledge a contribution of \$25. Members of the group nominate and discuss potential recipients in a special listserv until the group arrives at a consensus.
