Lifetime Achievement Award: The LAA Committee is discussing the four candidates chosen in the public voting phase. Dan Steffan, who is doing the certificate, expects to have a rough in the next week. Previous winners will also receive certificates when this year's winner is announced at the banquet.

Fan Activity Achievement Awards: The ballot is in full distribution and is available at www.corflu.org. FAAn Awards Administrator Andy Hooper has compiled and posted (www.corflu.org) a database of 2011 fanzines. Brad Foster's rough has been approved and the final version of the awards is in preparation.

Hotel: Meeting and guest accommodations reserved and confirmed. Rooms are blocked in a four-storey building convenient to restaurants and other facilities. Sunset Station has waived the daily resort fee.

Meeting Rooms: Now reserved for Friday afternoon and evening and Saturday. Larger banquet room reserved for Sunday.

Open Parties: Vegants Kick-Off Party (Thursday), Las Vegas Fandom Reunion (Friday) and New York Fandom Reunion (Saturday) and the Con-Closing Party (Sunday) are set. JoHn Hardin is compiling Vegas Fandom anthology and Arnie Katz is working on a collection of the artwork of Ross Chamberlain.
