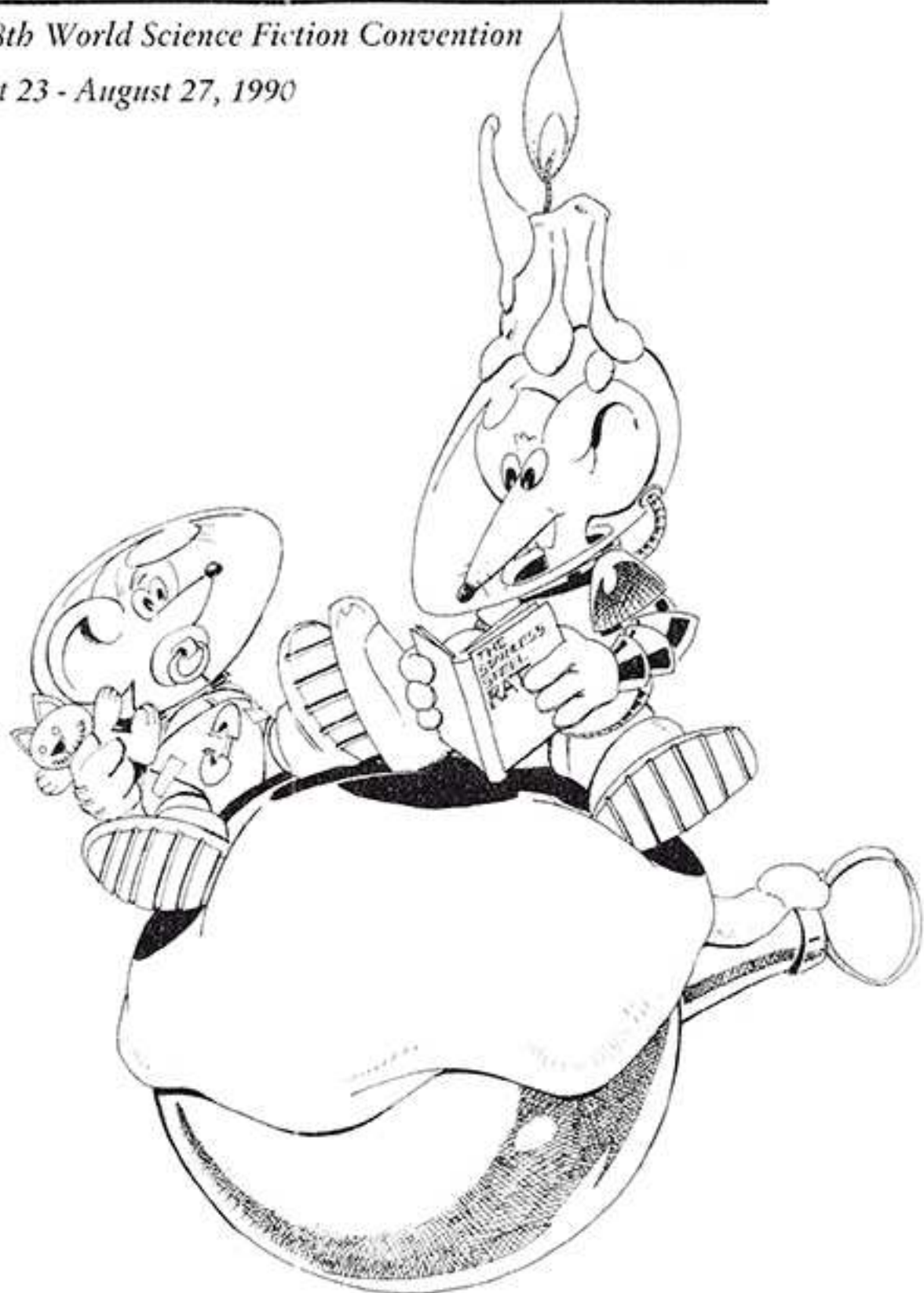

Guest of Honour

Joe Haldeman

Born in 1943 in Oklahoma, USA. Grew up in Puerto Rico, New Orleans, Washington D.C. and Alaska. Currently he divides his time between Gainesville, Florida and Cambridge, Massachusetts as well. He was a combat engineer in the Vietnam war and got a B.Sc. in astronomy. Has had a bewildering array of jobs: statistician's assistant, librarian, computer programmer, musician, labourer, occasional platform speaker and consultant. Besides these escapades, Joe is a teacher at various American Universities in Rhetoric and Writing. At the moment he is Assistant Professor at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. Here he

teaches, among other things astronomy, mathematics and English and a science fiction writing workshop. Since 1970 this work is combined with writing various kinds of books: anthologies, novels and short stories. Joe won the Hugo, Nebula and Ditmar Award for 'The Forever War' as best SF novel of 1975, a Hugo Award for 'Tricentennial' as the best 1976 short story. In 1978 he received the Galaxy Award for 'Mindbridge' and in 1983 his poem 'Saul's Death' won the Rhysling Award. His frequent trips to far flung parts of the globe will make it the more interesting to meet him in 1990.

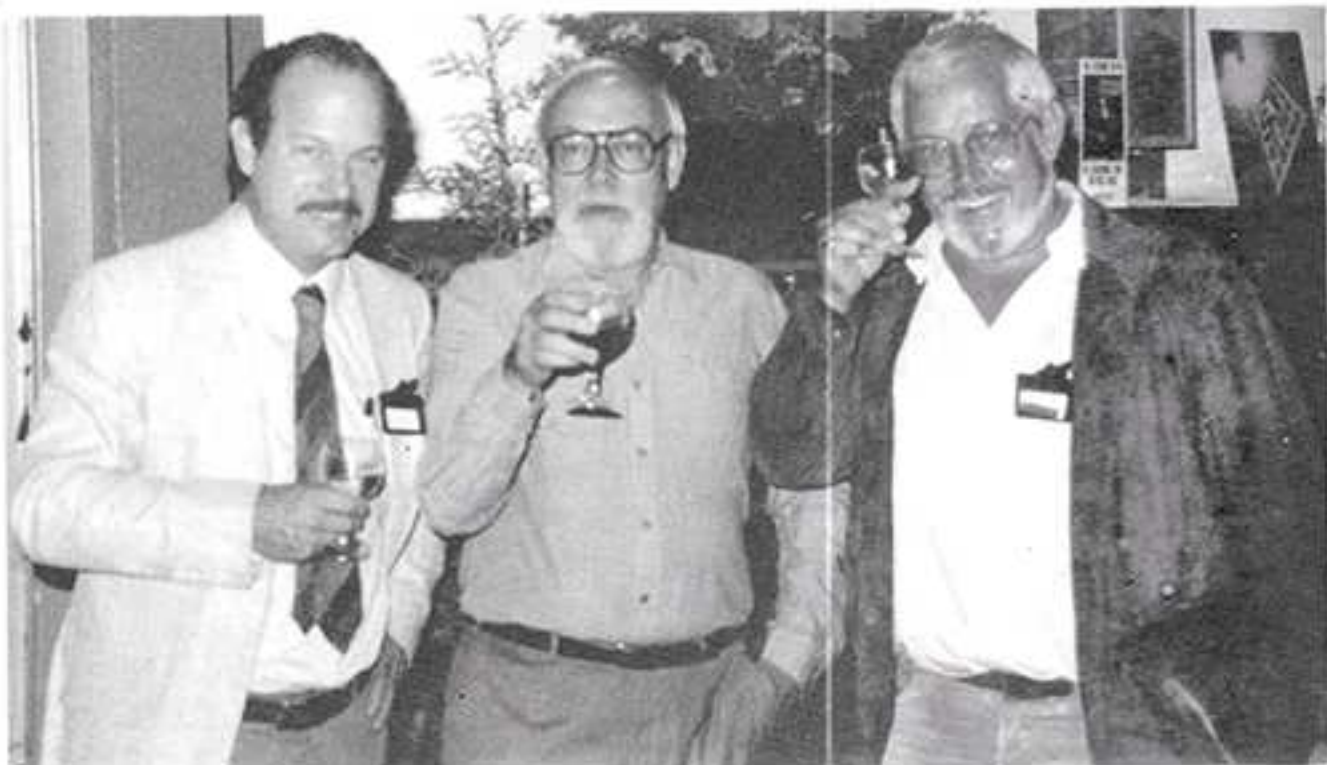
Guest of Honour

Harry Harrison

Who doesn't know the Stainless Steel Rat series, the Deathworld trilogy, the awarded Make Room! Make Room!, the Eden trilogy and many, many other novels, short stories and juveniles by this productive author? Not to mention his non fiction books or anthologies. His books have been translated in 23 languages, among them Chinese, Dutch, Esperanto, Russian, Hungarian and Lithuanian.

Harry was born in 1925 in Stamford, Connecticut (USA) but grew up in New York City. The United States Army grabbed

him, immediately after his eighteenth birthday. After a short term in college and a longer one in art school, he spent the next years in New York as an artist, art director and editor, finally ending up as a free-lance writer. With his wife Joan and his son Todd he went abroad to Mexico to work on his first novel. Having acquired a taste for travelling, he did not stop and became, with his family and newborn daughter Moira, a true world citizen - having lived in over 30 different countries.

Guest of Honour

Wolfgang Jeschke

Born in 1936. He grew up near Stuttgart, Germany. Here he graduated as a toolmaking craftsman and studied from 1959 at the University of Munich Philosophy, German and English. In 1969 he finished studies in practice on editing and book-selling in München. In 1969 he became editing assistant of the Beck'schen Verlagsbuchhandlung and later, 1970, editor with Kindlers Literatur Lexicon. Reason for us to make Wolfgang one of our Guests of Honour is his ongoing endeavour to promote Science Fiction in Germany. Since 1969 he issued the series 'Science Fiction für Kenner'. From 1973 up to 1979 he was the editor of the biographical encyclopedia 'Die Grossen der Weltge-

schichte' and since 1973 free-lance publisher of the Heyne Science Fiction series, one of the largest in the world. He has published in newspapers, magazines and anthologies and has issued over 80 SF-anthologies.

His most important publications in Germany: 'Supernova', 'Die Anderen', 'Der König und der Puppenmacher', 'Der Zeiter', 'Yeti', 'Nekromanten', 'Sibyllen im Herkules oder Instant Biester', 'Jona im Feuerofen', 'Midas oder Die Auferstehung des Fleisches'. He won the prestigious Kurd Lasswitz Award four times, and in 1985 he received the Literature Award of the German Science Fiction Club. Two years later he received the World SF Harrison Award.

Fan Guest of Honour

Andrew Ian Porter

Was born 1946 in Detroit, Michigan. Has been addicted to science fiction since he was ten years old. Became active in fandom in 1961 and started publishing a weekly news magazine, understandably called 'SF Weekly'. He then strove to publish a well-produced semi-professional magazine, *Algol*, that changed its name to *Starship* in 1978. Unfortunately *Starship* ceased publication in 1984. Thanks

to his desire to provide the fannish community with news Andy also had started an international monthly newsmagazine, called *Science Fiction Chronicle* (since then nominated for a Hugo Award several times). As Fan Guest of Honour he is likely to tell us about the interesting development of international fandom.

Toastmistress

Chelsea Quinn Yarbro

Born in 1942, she is well-known for her science fiction as well for her detective novels. Her first story was published in 1969 in *Worlds of If*: 'The Posture of the Prophecy'. Many other stories and novels followed, including the renowned 'Times of the Fourth Horseman' and 'Frog Pond', the latter

being nominated for a Nebula Award. Aside from her writing Chelsea is also into composing, writings operas and lyrics. In her free time she happens to be a passionate cook which makes her, aside from her many other talents, an ideal Toastmistress for ConFiction.

World Science Fiction Society

Most of you, of course, already know what WSFS stands for and what it does. Still, for those new to SF World fandom, we'd like to give a short introduction.

The World Science Fiction Society is in fact the international overall organization that controls the procedures for choosing the sites for the annual Worldconventions and the occasional North American Science Fiction Convention (also known as Nasfic). It also keeps a firm hand on the regulations for the election of (and voting for) Hugo Award candidates, and on the financial proceedings of any World-

con committee. The WSFS is controlled by an annual business meeting, to be held at every Worldconvention. Any attending convention member can join the meetings and is in fact a member of the WSFS itself. In these meetings votes of censure or confidence, that have been agreed upon the year before, are ratified. At the same time new ideas and suggestions are discussed and acknowledged or not, to be ratified in the following year. To cut a long story short: the WSFS is the United Nations of Science Fiction fans.

Mark Registration and Protection Committee

This Committee has also to do with the overall WSFS. At ConFiction there will be a special meeting of a board of WSFS members that will guard the service marks as 'Worldcon' and 'Hugo Award', WSFS trade marks.

1993 Site Selection Procedures

During ConFiction in 1990 the site will be chosen for the 51st Worldcon. Any bidding committee has to notify ConFiction, that will inform the WSFS, and prepare the 1993 site selection ballots and the necessary arrangements within the programme of ConFiction.

The site selection forms for the Worldcon in 1993 will be sent to all attendees/members of ConFiction in Spring 1990, with our Progress Report 4.

General Information

Hotel business

Having a conventional site is just one part of the package. The other one is, of course, hotel and travel. In order to secure an optimal service to all members of ConFiction we are happy to announce that we have signed a contract with a very experienced and well-known ingoing tour operator in the Netherlands, called Convention Travel International. It has an excellent reputation with hotels and bookings over the past twenty years, enhanced by its co-operation with the Congress Building, after all one of the major European congress centres. Convention Travel International will handle all hotel registrations for our members, except for North-American fans. They will be served by Ask Mr. Foster in liaison with Convention Travel International. When we mail out the hotel forms you can expect both acknowledgement and a room within 3 weeks upon receipt of your form. More, much more of this in our Progress Report 2.

We are also very happy - especially for our North American members - to announce an agreement with Ask Mr. Foster/Group Events in Stamford USA, who will handle both air, ground and hotel reservations. With this unique service for Fandom we hope to offer those members from the New World a fast, good and reliable service, that will deliver you right upon our doorsteps. Full details as well as the opening of a special 800 number for ConFiction will be released in our next Progress Report.

Huckster's Room & Art Show

We will set up information and rates for the Huckster's Room and the Art Show not before 1988. So, please wait for Progress Report 2 for that information (including such matters as clearance, custom regulations etc). But if you send us your name and adress now (as well as any corrections in the future), we'll include you in our Special Mailing List.

Participation and information

You like to participate in ConFiction? With A Costume That Will End All Masquerades? As a dealer, with tons of books and goodies? In the Art Show? With a program event Never Seen Before? With your help (and we will need you) we can make it happen. Or you want information about any subject?

Don't hesitate and write us. It's a bit too early to say anything about our program, but we want to give you the feeling it is your programme as well as ours. Do not hesitate to send your wishes, ideas, recommendations and questions to ConFiction. Each and anyone of you will get an answer. Drugs

Let there be no misunderstanding. The possession and use of drugs in Holland is illegal. Yes, we are a tolerant and permissive country, but believe us: our nation's tole-

rance towards drugs is very thin indeed. Towards any drug! Two months to two years in prison plus missing the convention, would be a waste of your time and money. Don't spoil it! Remember, we did promise you an exciting convention. And we can do it without any artificial stimulation. So can you.

Weapons

Likewise the only weapons we want to see in our lovely city and convention site are those carried by the local precinct of Hill Street Blues. Cops. We are a peace-loving

nation and we want to keep it that way. Besides, we like to follow the general no-weapons policy of all major conventions all over the world. More about this in the forthcoming issue.

As far as the use weapons for the Masquerade is concerned, when writing this Progress Report, negotiations with our police and customs have started. We already obtained permission for the special events of ConFiction, such as the Masquerade. More details will be disclosed in future Progress Reports.

Advertising Rates

Our advertising rates are based upon print run and publication costs of our Progress Reports. Rates may increase slightly, but we will keep you informed about any change in rates and about the rates for the Programme Book. Read it all in Progress Report 2!

All copy should be camera ready. If not, then any work process required (tones, screens, reversing out etc.) will be invoiced to the advertiser at cost.

Payment

Regrettably we have to ask you to send us your payment together with the ad copy. For methods of payment: see information on memberships but be sure to add reason for payment.

Discount

Discount will be given on both professional and fan rates for multiple pages, rates available on request. If you want to run an identical-sized ad in Progress Report 3, you'll entitled to a discount of 10%. Add on an ad in Progress Report 4 and you'll get a 20% discount!

Membership Rates

Important notice! Our membership rates are based upon the current daily exchange rate of the US dollar. Should the dollar drop by more than 10% of the current value (as per November 16, 1987 \$1.00 = f 1.80) then we are forced to adjust the price to match the exchange rate of the Dutch membership rates. However, if the dollar rises and passes the f 2.00 limit, US membership rates will be adjusted. Members who have paid too much during that period will be reimbursed at ConFiction. This upon showing a receipt that we will mail out by the end of each year. Fluctuations of less than \$5.00 will not be reimbursed as banking fees and administration costs are equal to, or even exceeding \$5.00.

ConFiction offers you two types of memberships: Attending and Supporting. Either choice entitles you to voting rights the Hugo Award and for the site selection for 1993 (by mail or at the convention itself), all of the Progress Reports, any Newsletter appearing after you have joined, the programme book and any post-convention publication. An Attending Membership also buys you the right to attend ConFiction and all the programmes therein, including the meetings of the World Science Fiction Society business meetings.

As a supporting member, you may convert to an attending member at any time by paying the difference between an attending and supporting membership.
