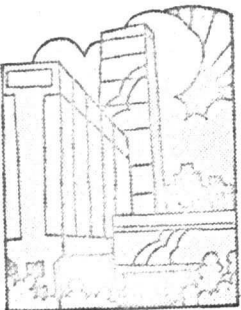
Dear Secret Masters of Noreascon:
